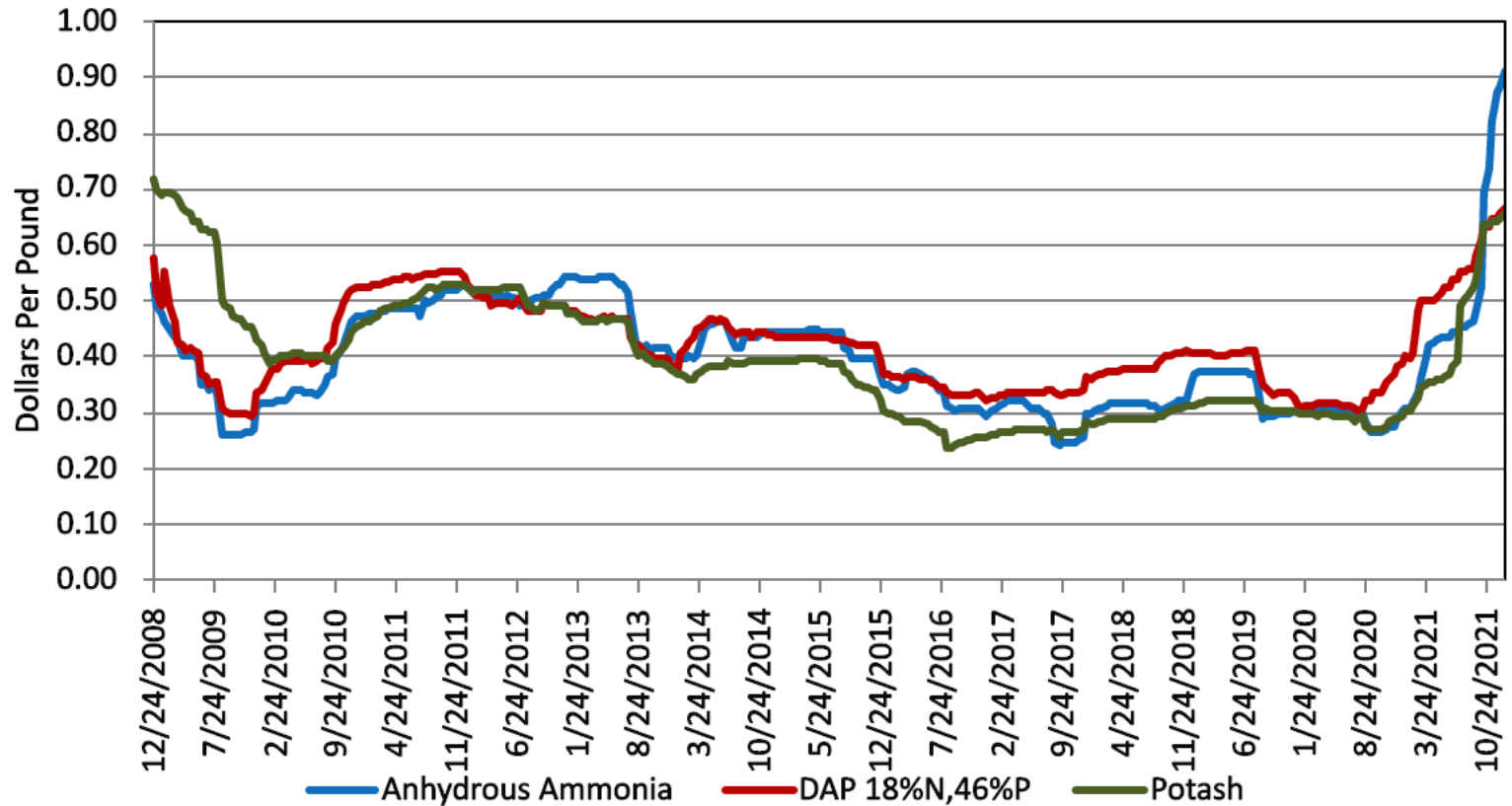

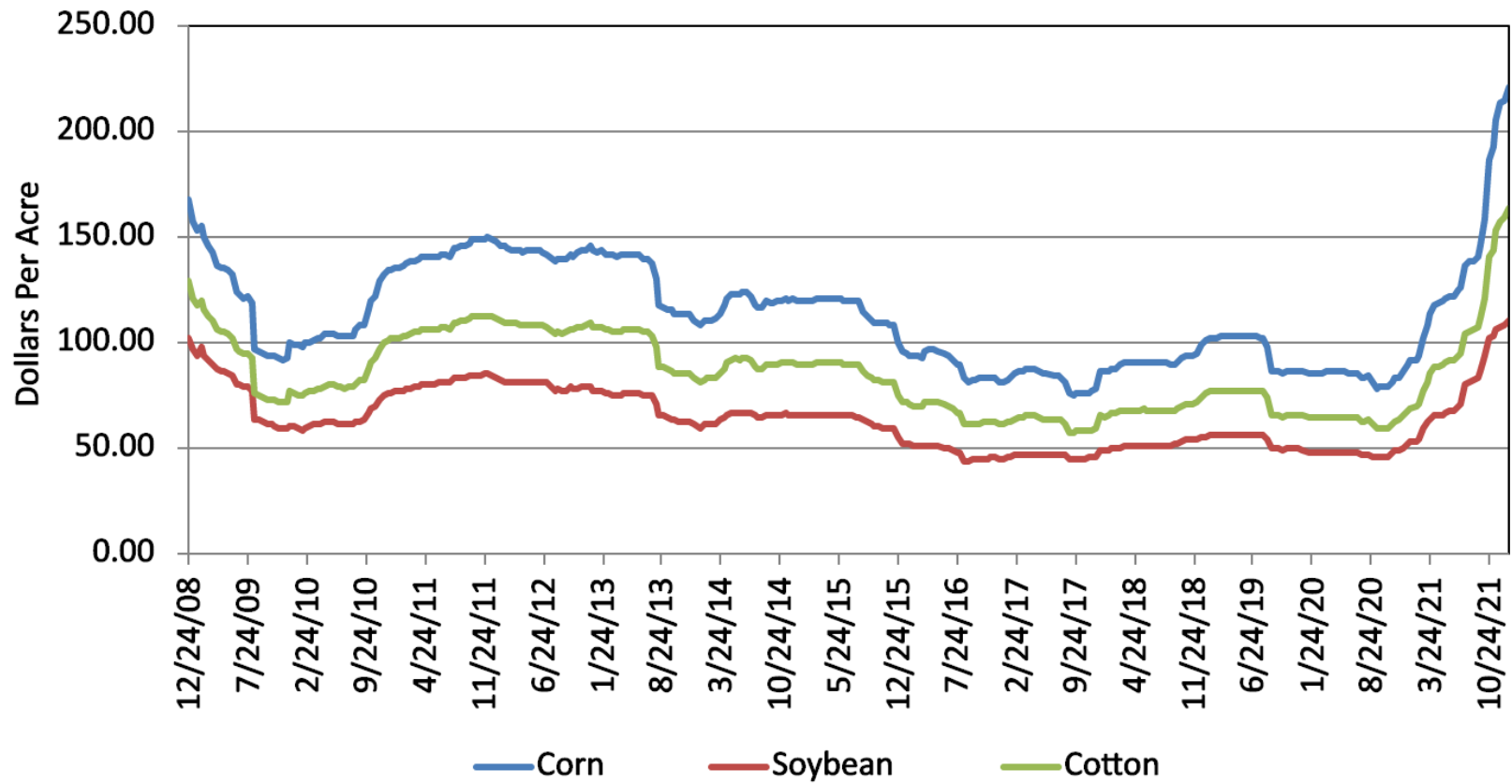

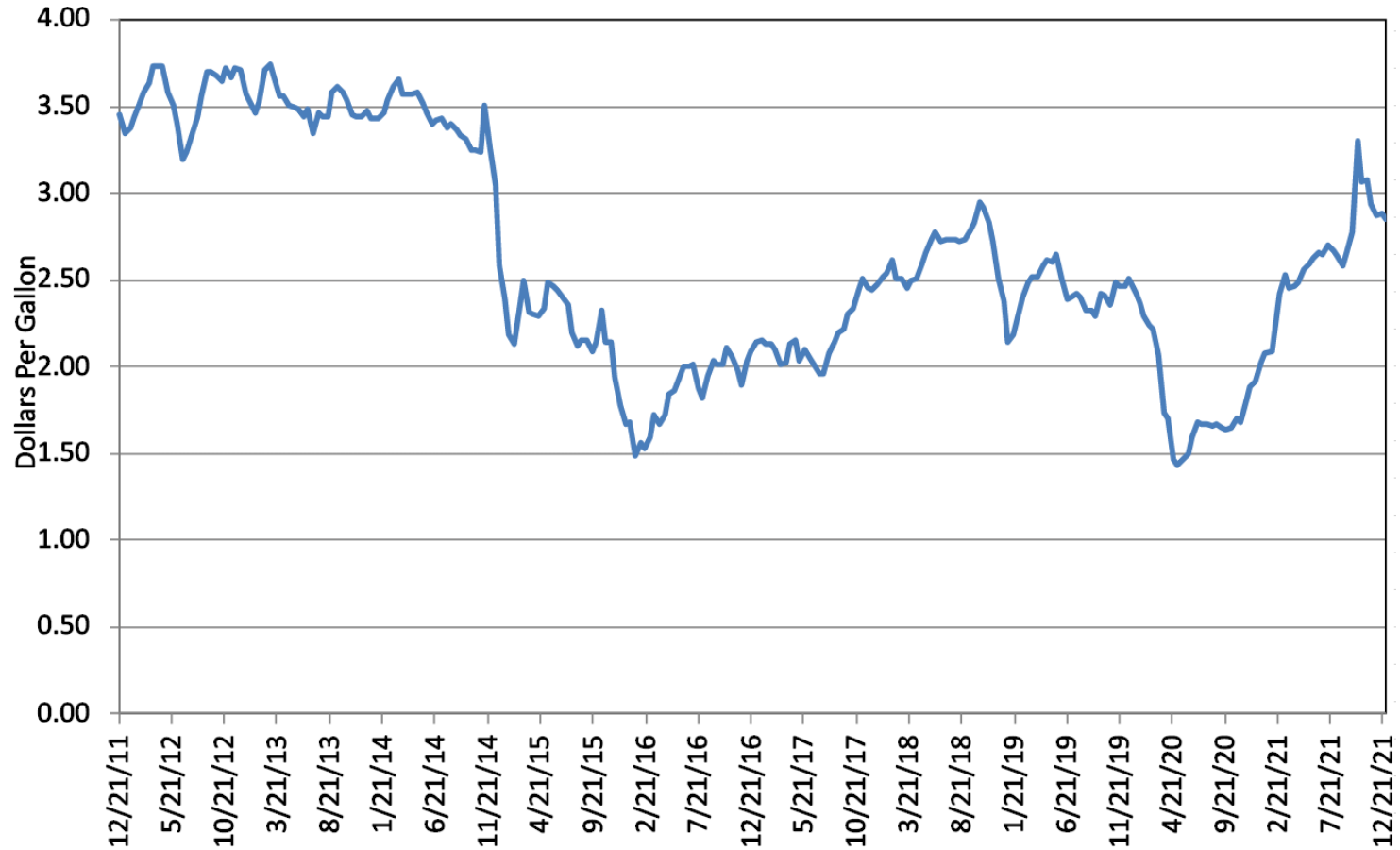
# Fertilizer Prices



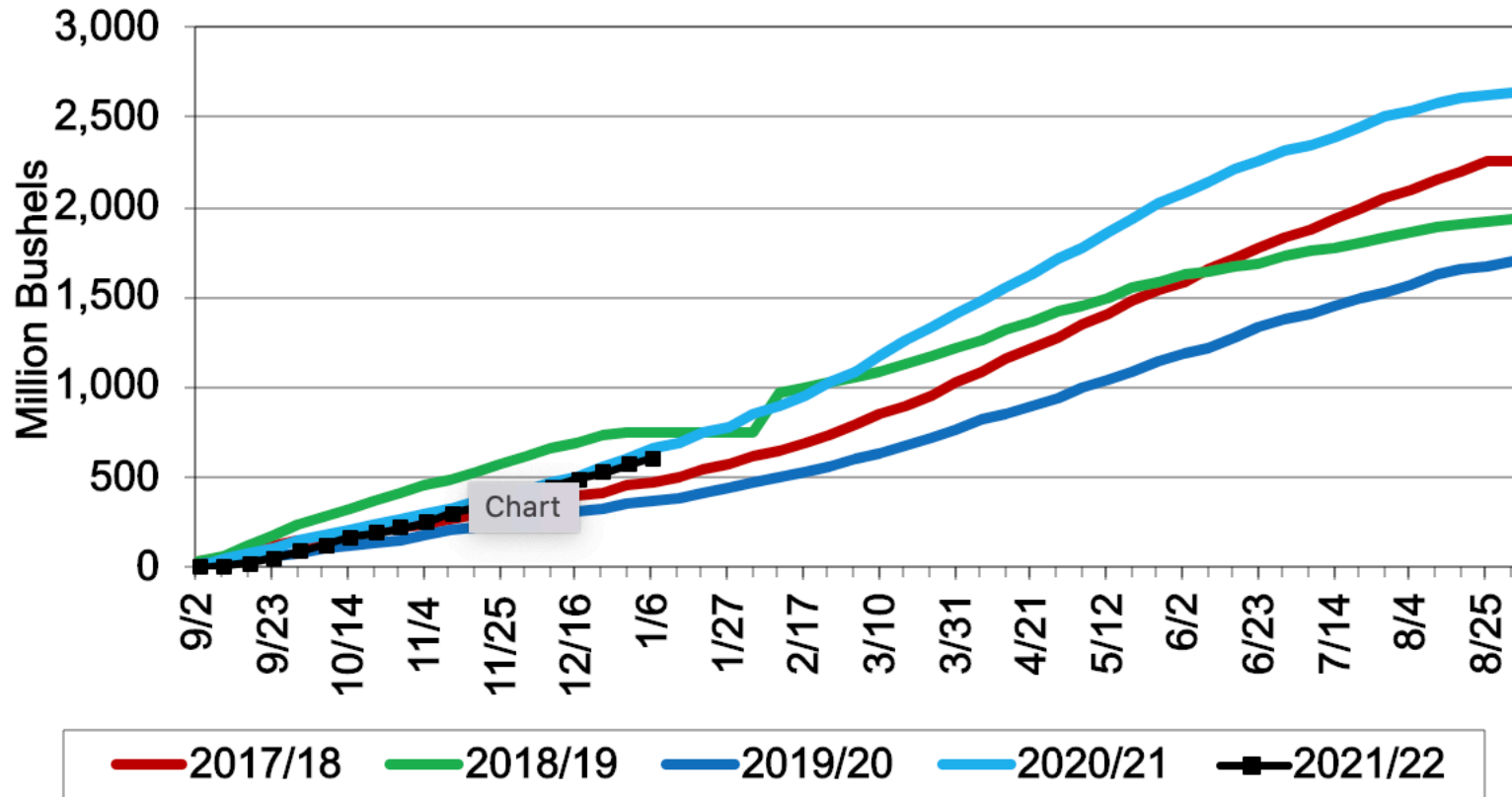
# Fertilizer Prices Per Acre

# Accumulated US Corn Exports to All Countries

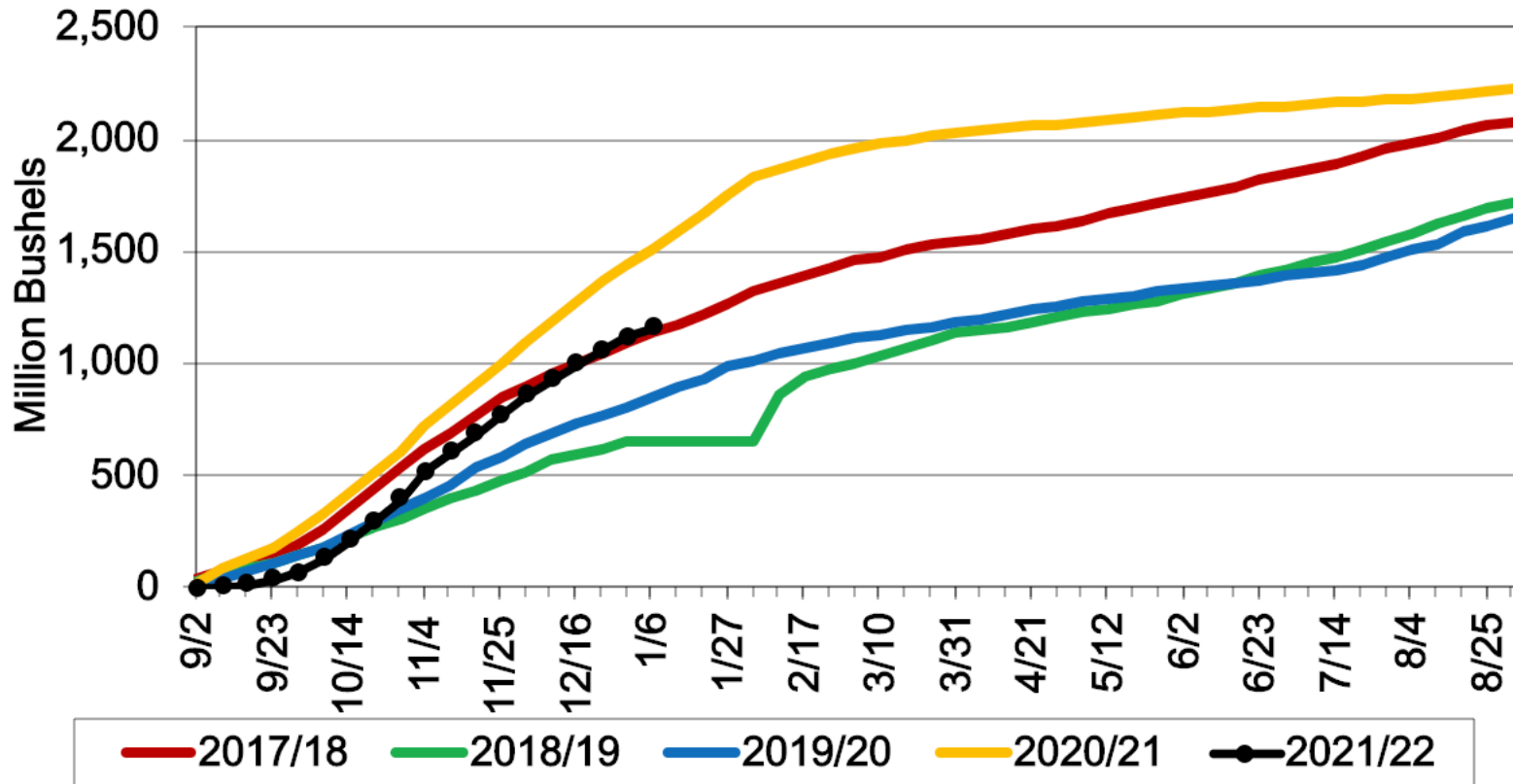


# Corn Export Summary

- Net Sales increased 79% from the previous week but down 59% from the prior 4-week average at 18 MBU.
- Increases were largely credited to Mexico (10.98 MBU), Japan (9.2 MBU), and China (2.8 MBU).
- Exports were up 3% from the previous week, and down 1% from the prior 4-week average, totaling 39.8 MBU.
- The destinations were primarily to Mexico (13.7 MBU), China (10.8 MBU), and Japan (5.2 MBU).



# Accumulated US Soybean Exports to All Countries



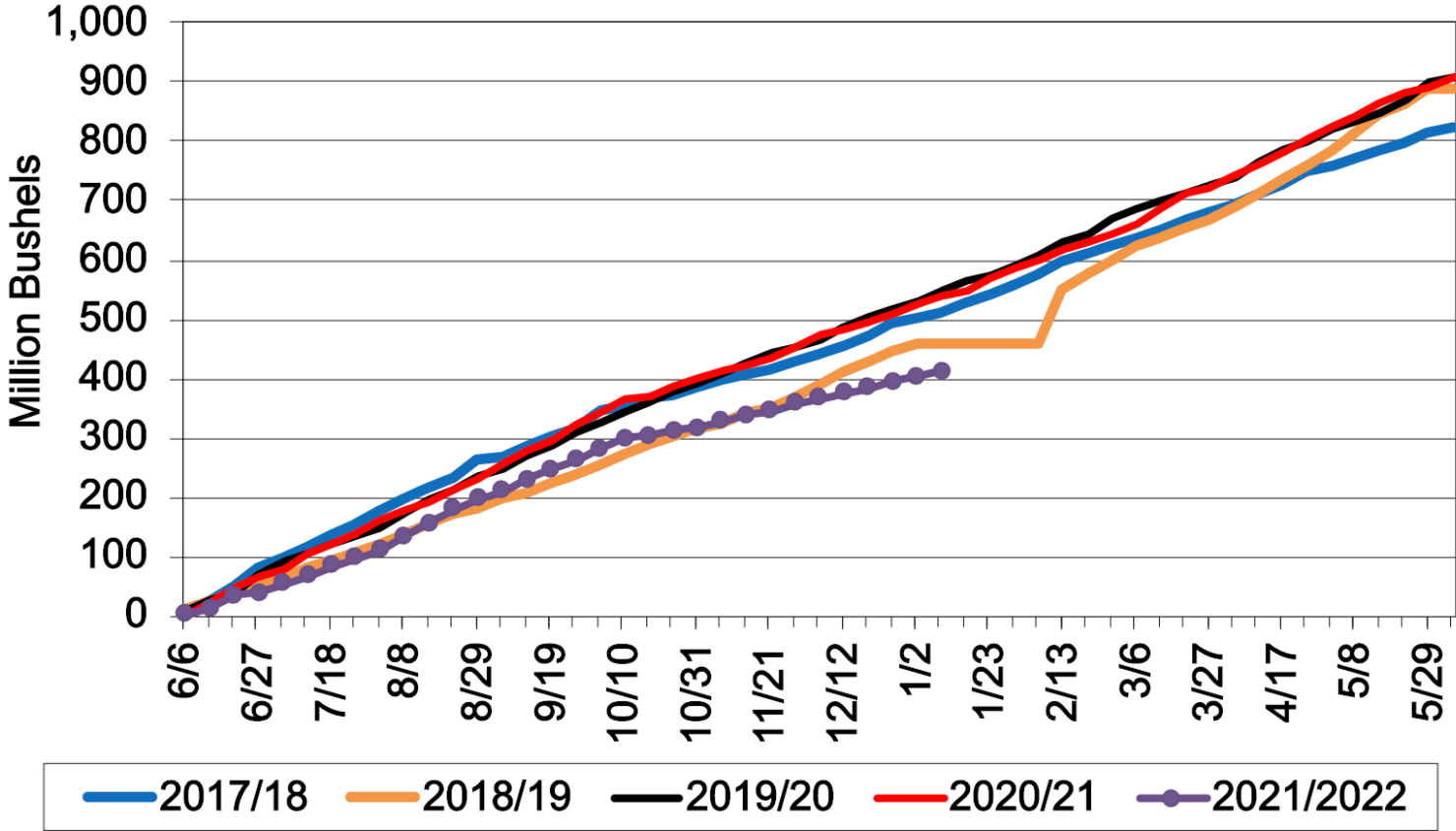
# Soybean Export Summary

- Net Sales totaled 27 MBU, an increase of 92% compared to the previous week but down 1% compared to the previous 4-week average.
- Increases are accredited to China (11.1 MBU), Mexico (6.9 MBU), and Egypt (6.5 MBU).
- Net Sales for 2022/2023 totaled 6.7 MBU and was primarily for unknown destinations (4.4 MBU).
- Exports were at 37.5 MBU, down 42% from the week prior and down 43% from the previous 4-week average.
- The primary destinations were China (18 MBU), Mexico (4 MBU), and Egypt (3.9 MBU).





# Accumulated US Wheat Exports to All Countries

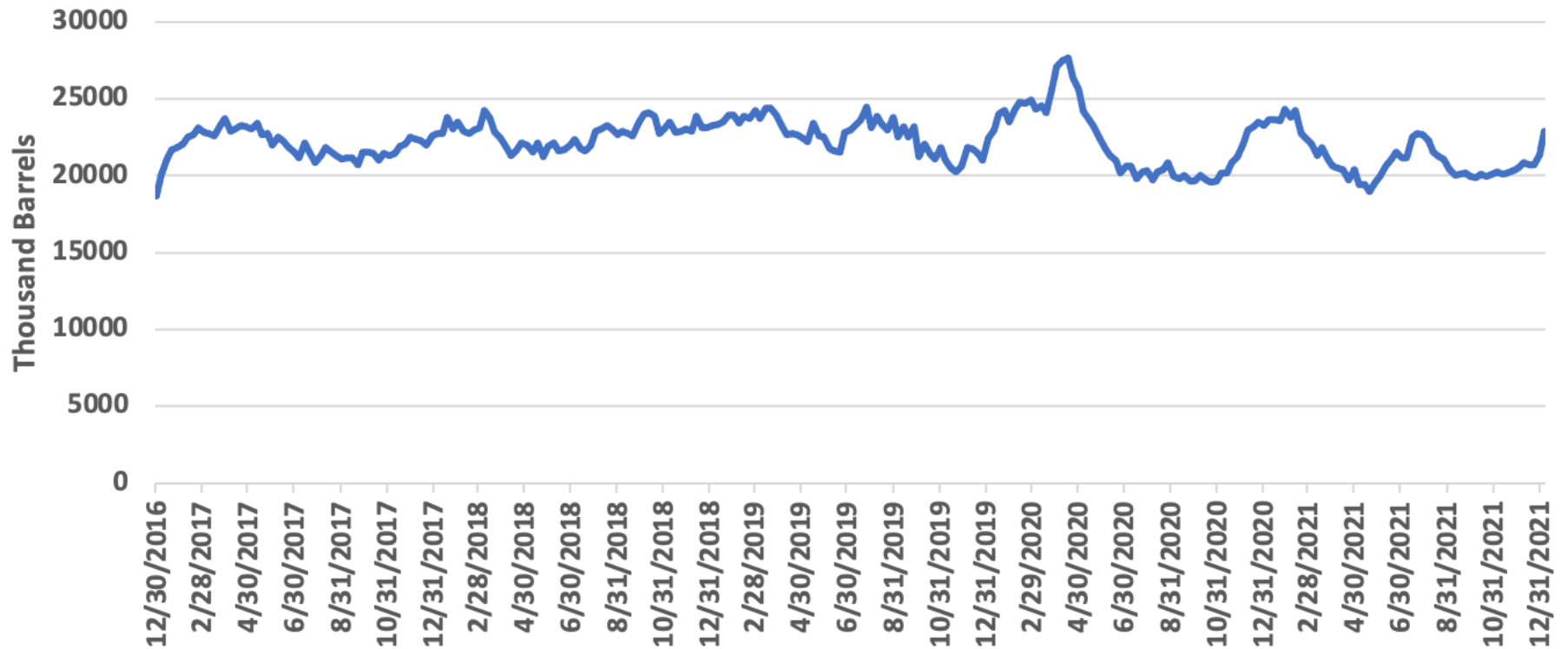


# Wheat Export Summary

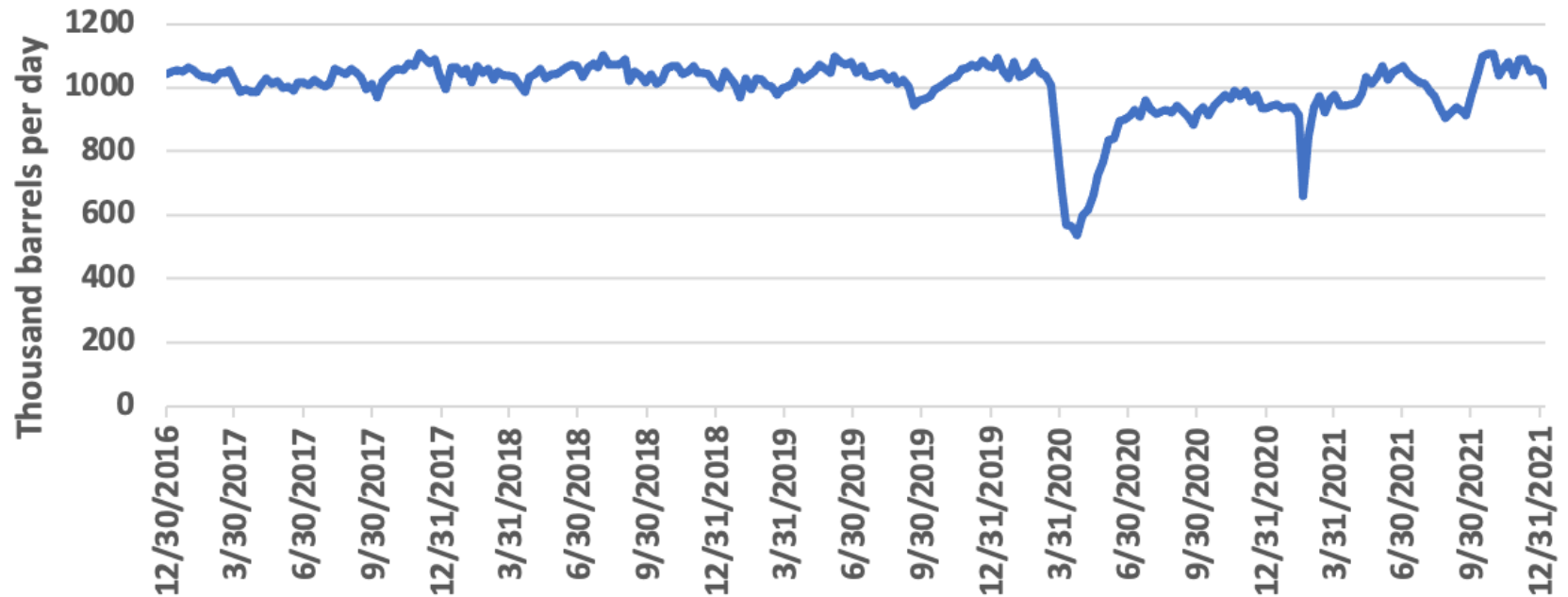
- Net Sales were at 9.7 MBU, an increase from the prior week, but a decrease of 20% from the previous 4-week average.
- Increases were primarily for the Philippines (1.8 MBU) and for Mexico (1.6 BU)
- Exports were up 23% from the previous week, and 2% from the prior 4-week average, totaling to 9.5 MBU.
- Destinations were primarily Japan (2.2 MBU), Indonesia (2.2 MBU), and Mexico (2.1 MBU).
