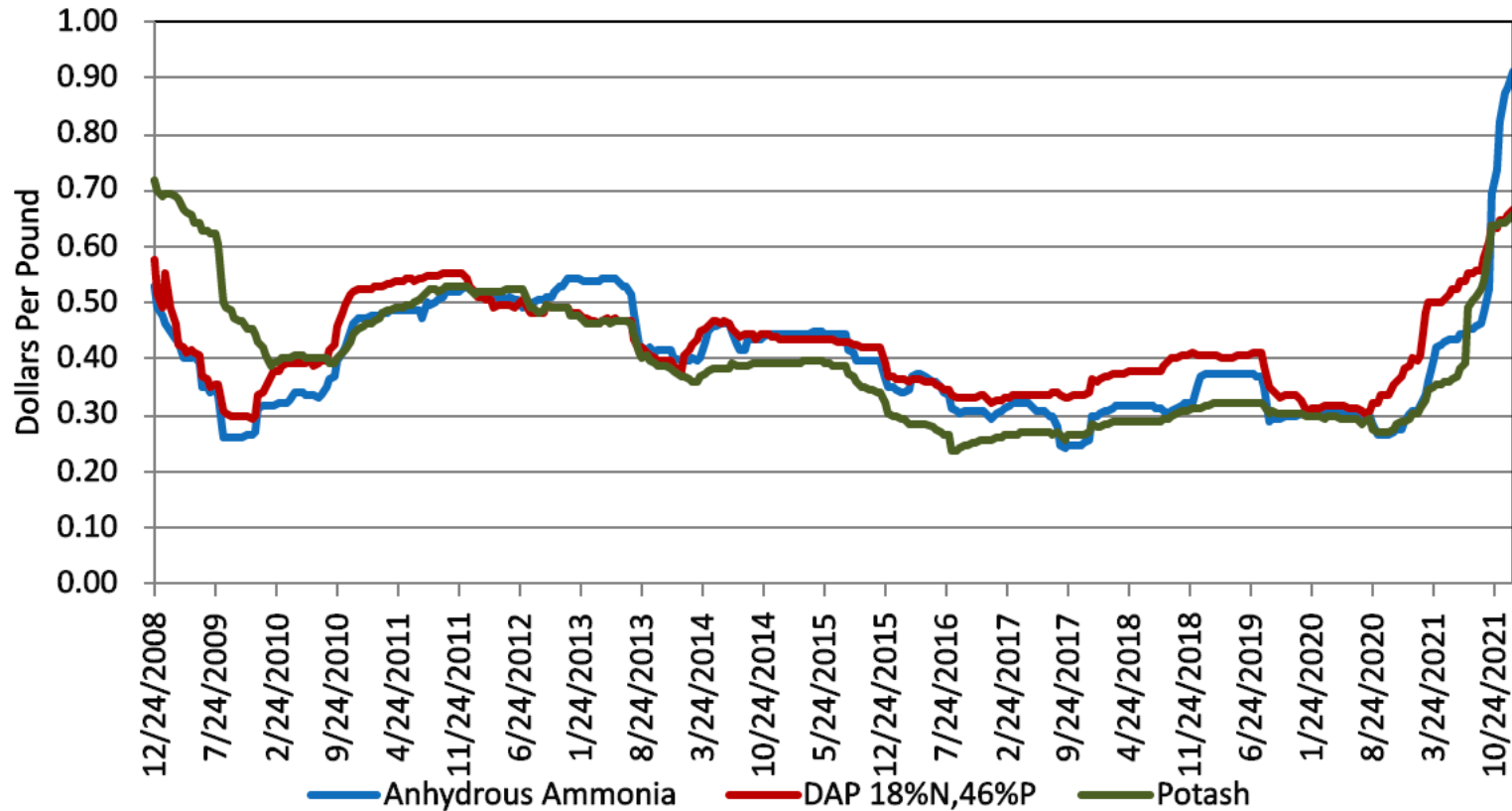

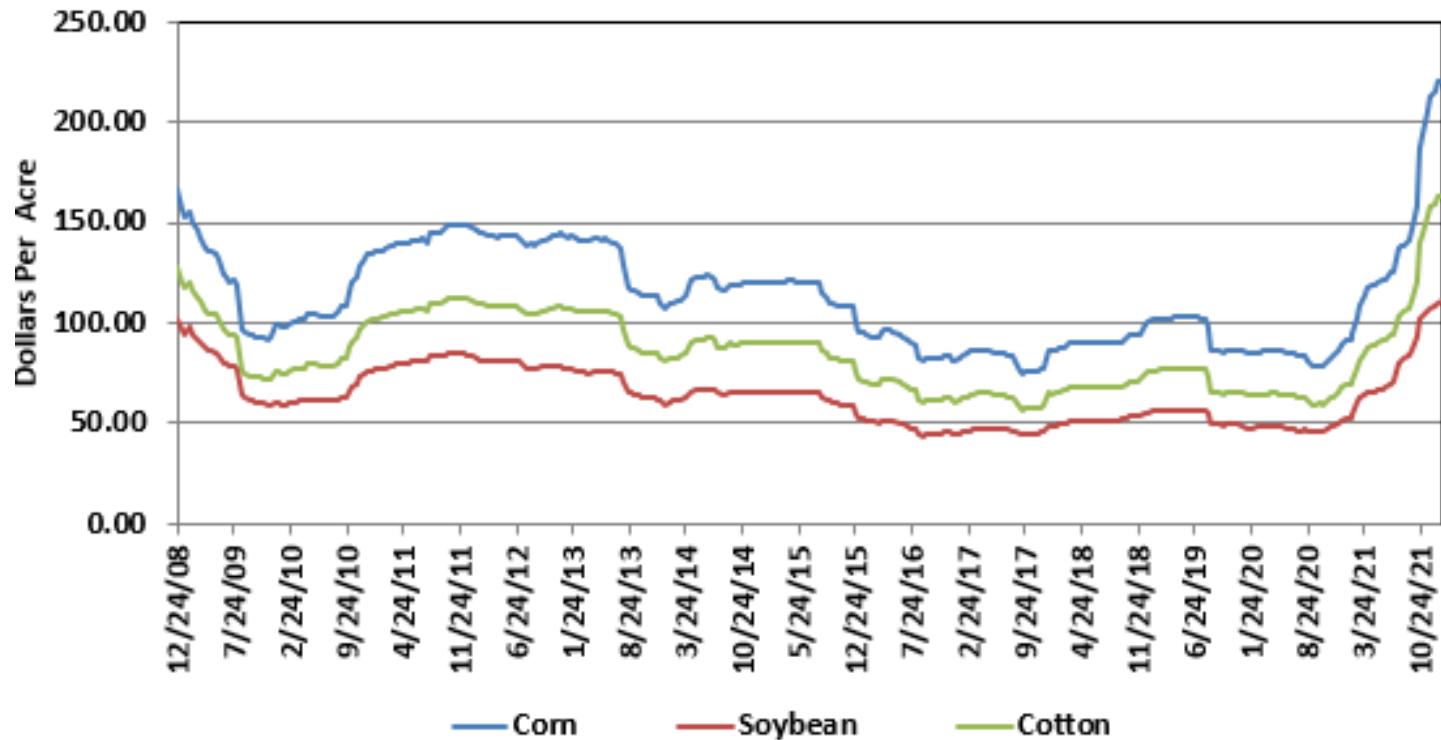

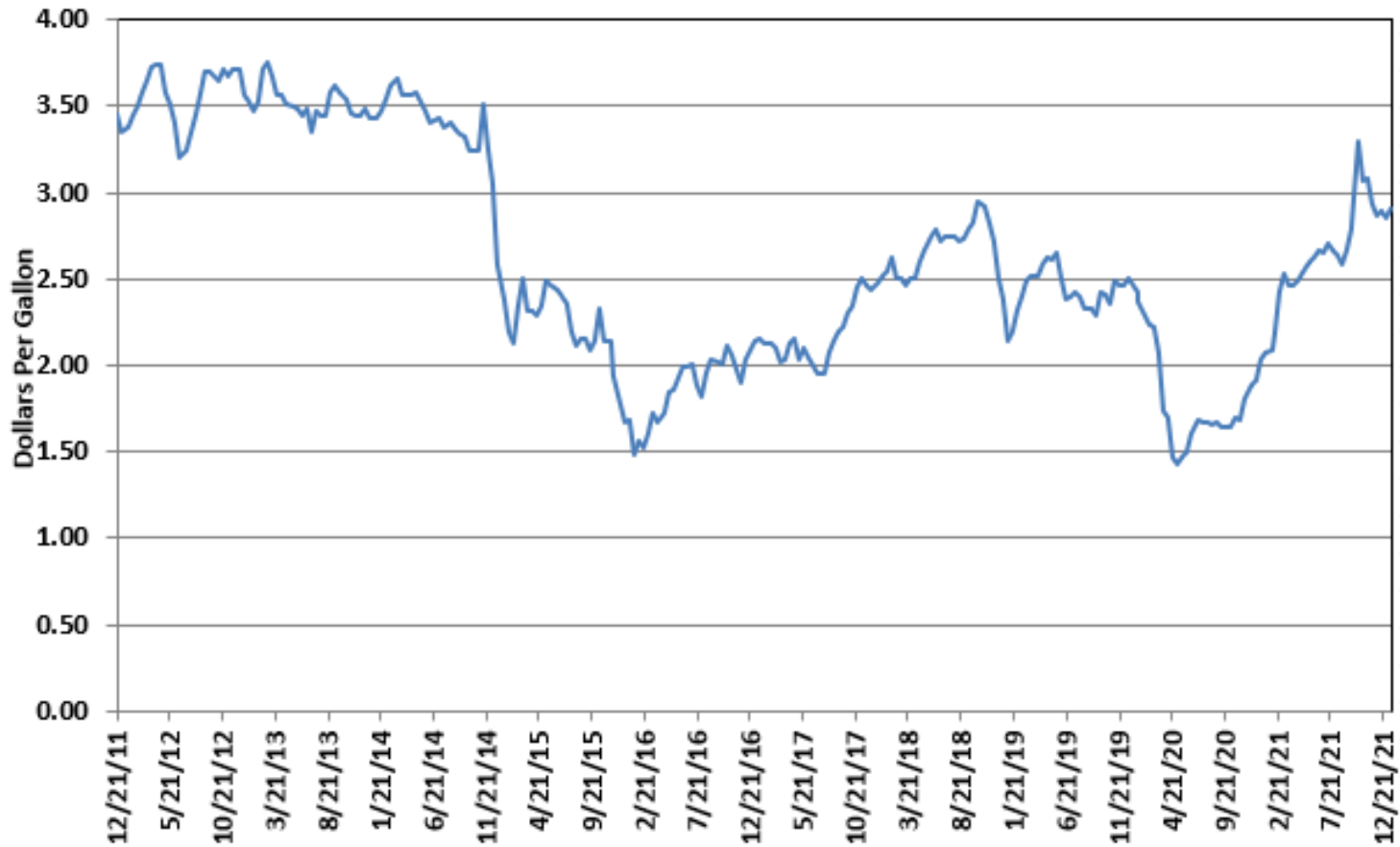
Fertilizer Prices



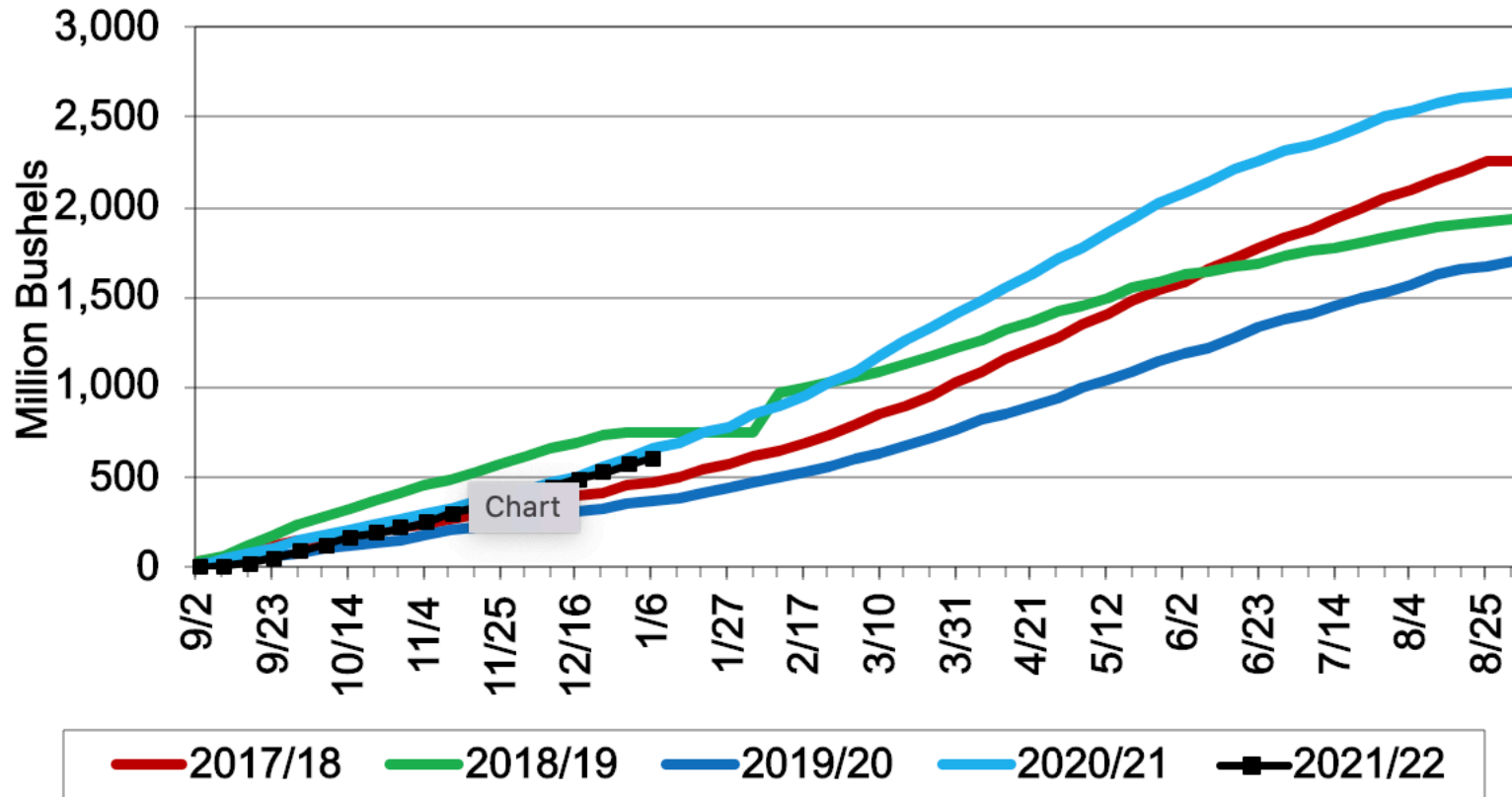
Fertilizer Prices Per Acre

Accumulated US Corn Exports to All Countries

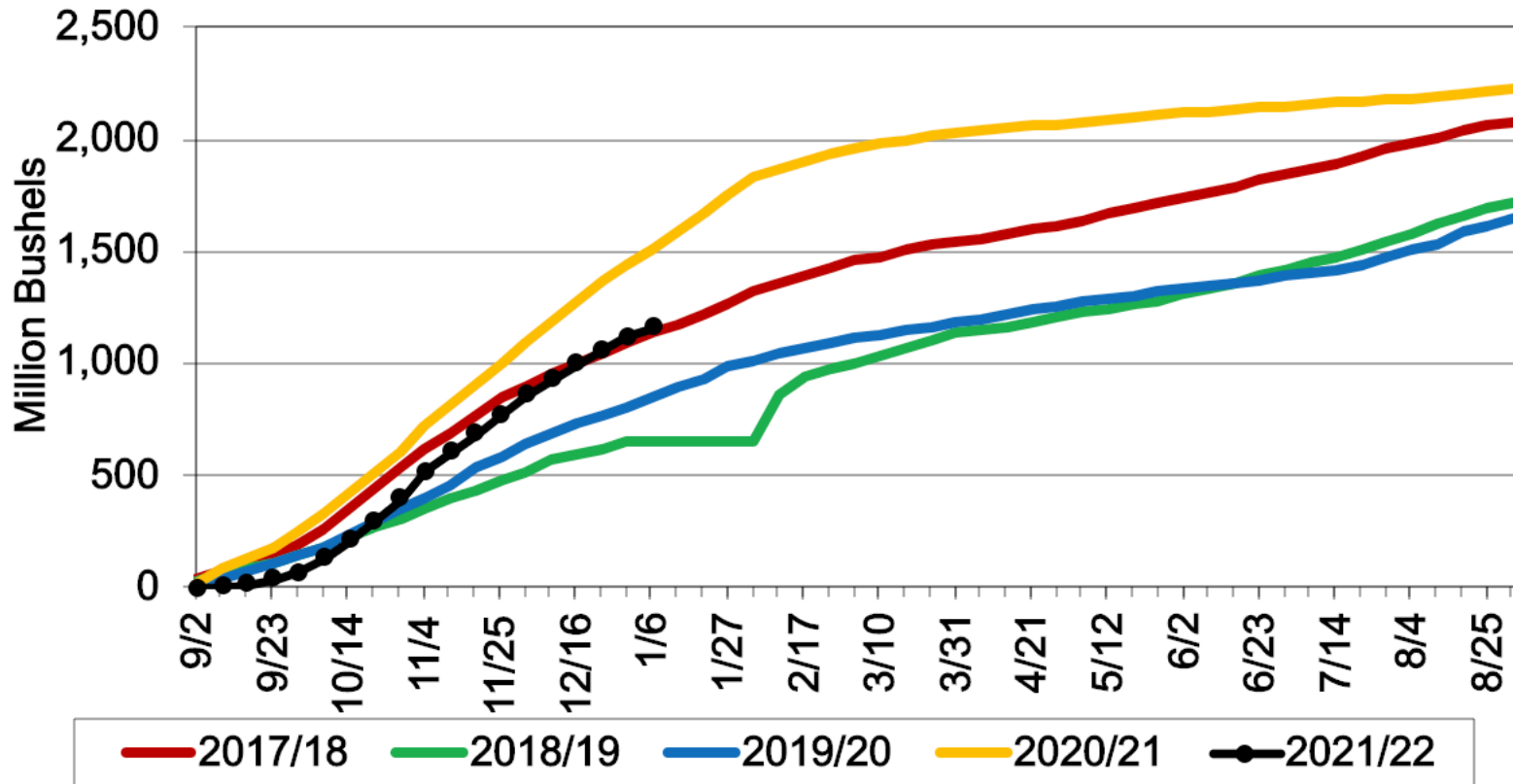


Corn Export Summary

- Net Sales for 2021 /2022 increased 48% from the prior 4-week average at 42.96 MBU.
- Increases were largely credited to Japan (14.6 MBU), Mexico (9.7 MBU), and Colombia (3.4 MBU).
- Net Sales for 2022/2023 totaled 4.1 MBU and was primarily for Mexico (2.2 MBU) and Japan (1.97 MBU).
- Exports were at a marketing year high at 51.1 MBU, which was up 28% from the previous week, and 29% from the prior 4-week average.
- The destinations were primarily to China (13.8 MBU), Mexico(12.7 MBU), and Japan (8.4 MBU).



Accumulated US Soybean Exports to All Countries

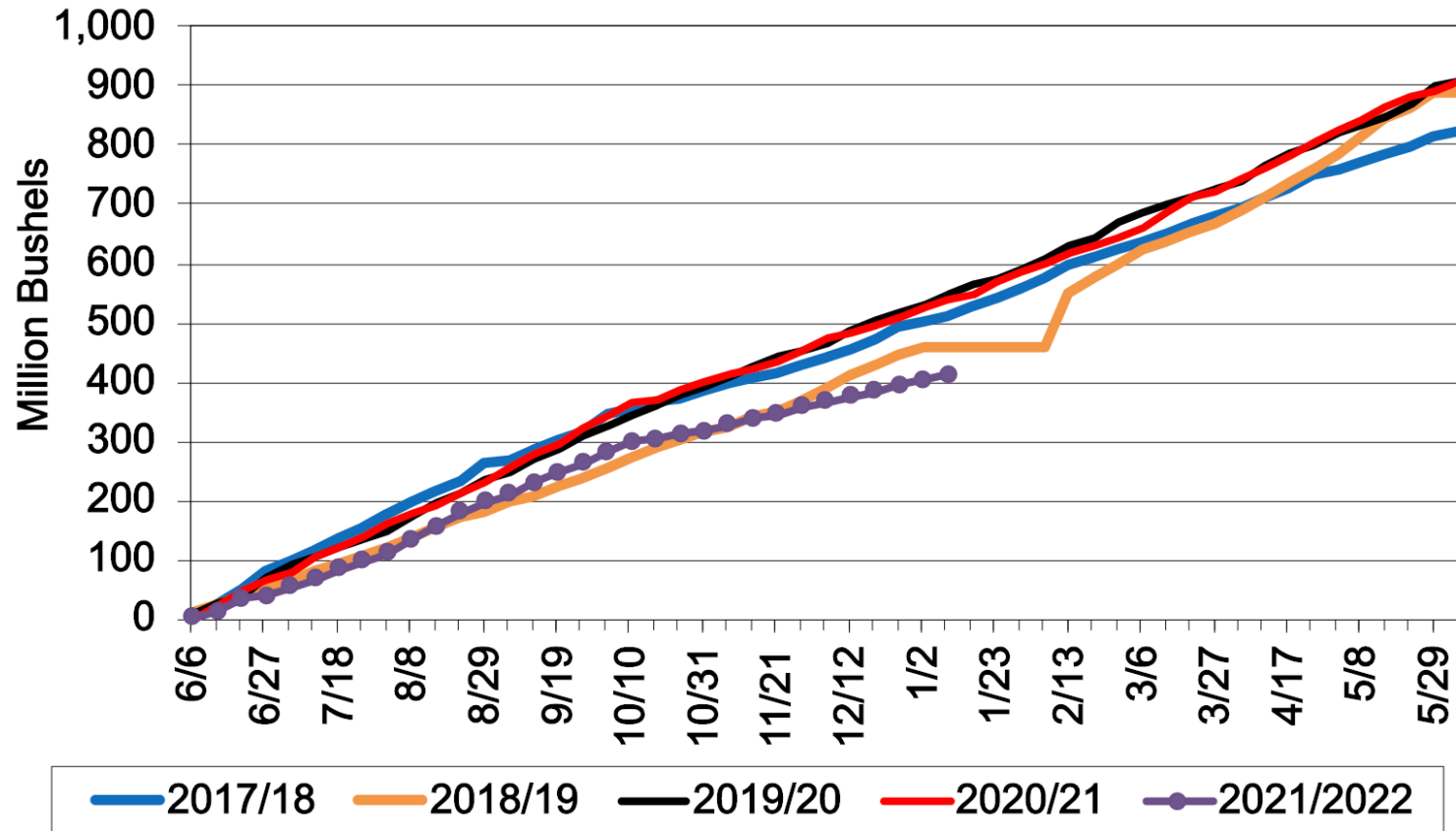


Soybean Export Summary

- Net Sales for 2021 /2022 totaled 24.7 MBU, a decrease of 9% compared to the previous week but up 12% compared to the previous 4-week average.
- Increases are accredited to China (29.3 MBU), Mexico (12.99 MBU), and Spain (5.1 MBU).
- Net Sales for 2022/2023 totaled 19.4 MBU and was primarily for China (16.97 MBU).
- Exports were at 66.3 MBU, up 77% from the week prior and 15% from the previous 4-week average.
- The primary destinations were China (45.97 MBU), Mexico (5.5 MBU), and Spain (5.1 MBU).



Accumulated US Wheat Exports to All Countries

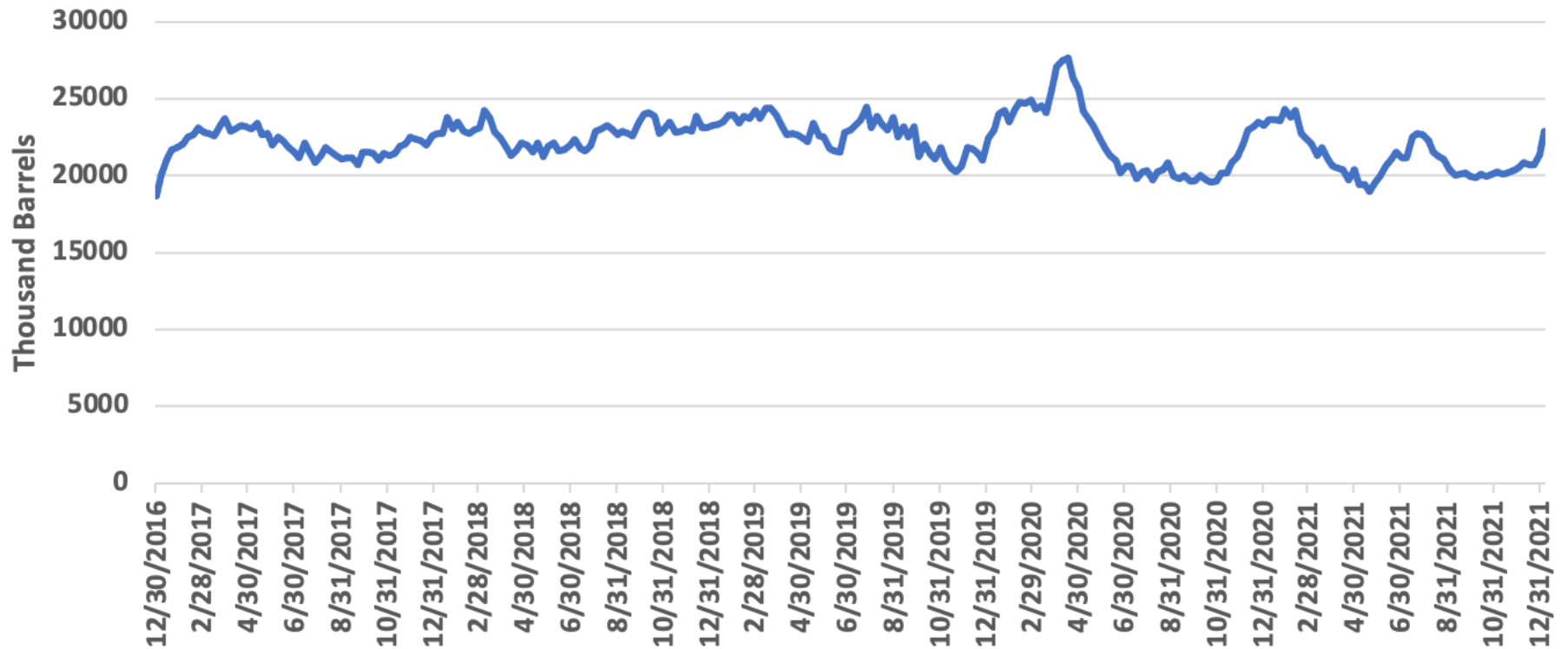


Wheat Export Summary

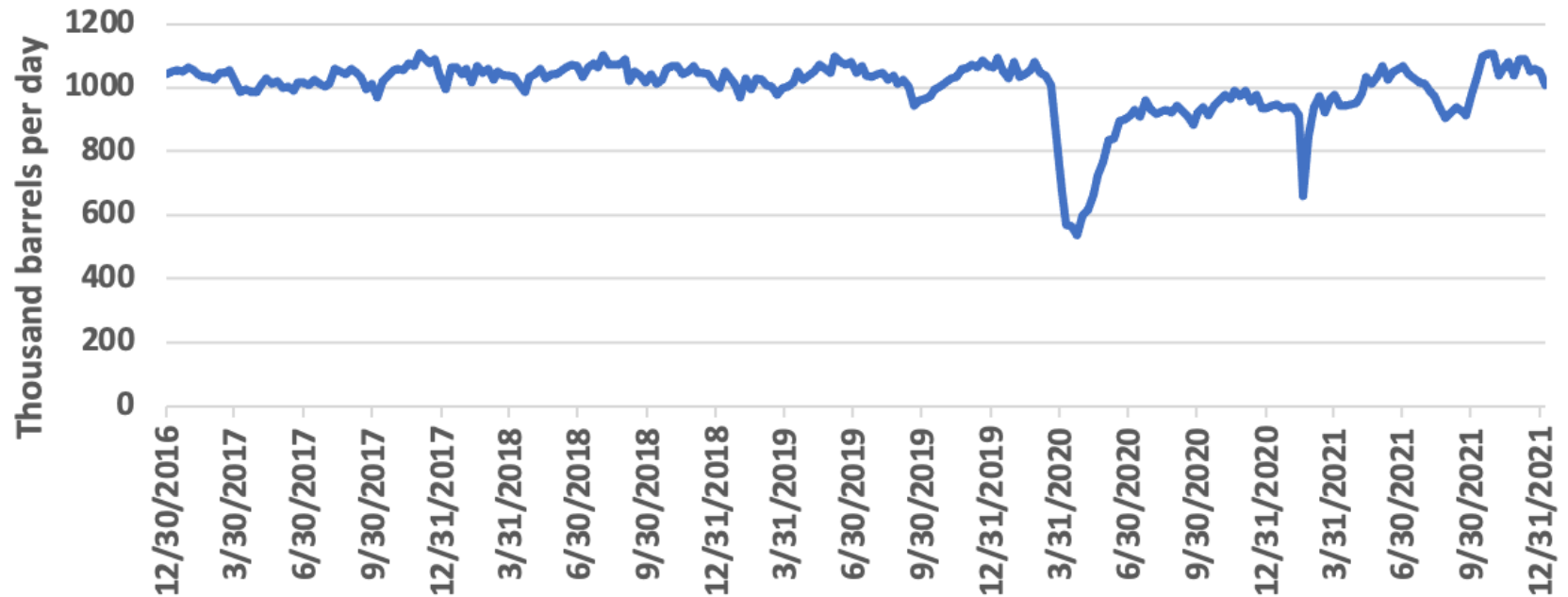
- Net Sales for 2021 /2022 were at 13.98 MBU, an increase of 44% from the prior week, and 62% from the previous 4-week average.
- Increases were primarily for the Nigeria (3.7 MBU), Guatemala (2.4 MBU) and for Japan (2.1 MBU) - Net Sales for 2022/2023 totaled to 2.6 MBU and was primarily for Thailand (2 MBU).
- Exports were up 52% from the previous week, and 57% from the prior 4-week average, totaling to 14.4 MBU.
- Destinations were primarily Mexico (3.7 MBU), Vietnam (2.5 MBU), and the Philippines (2.1 MBU)
