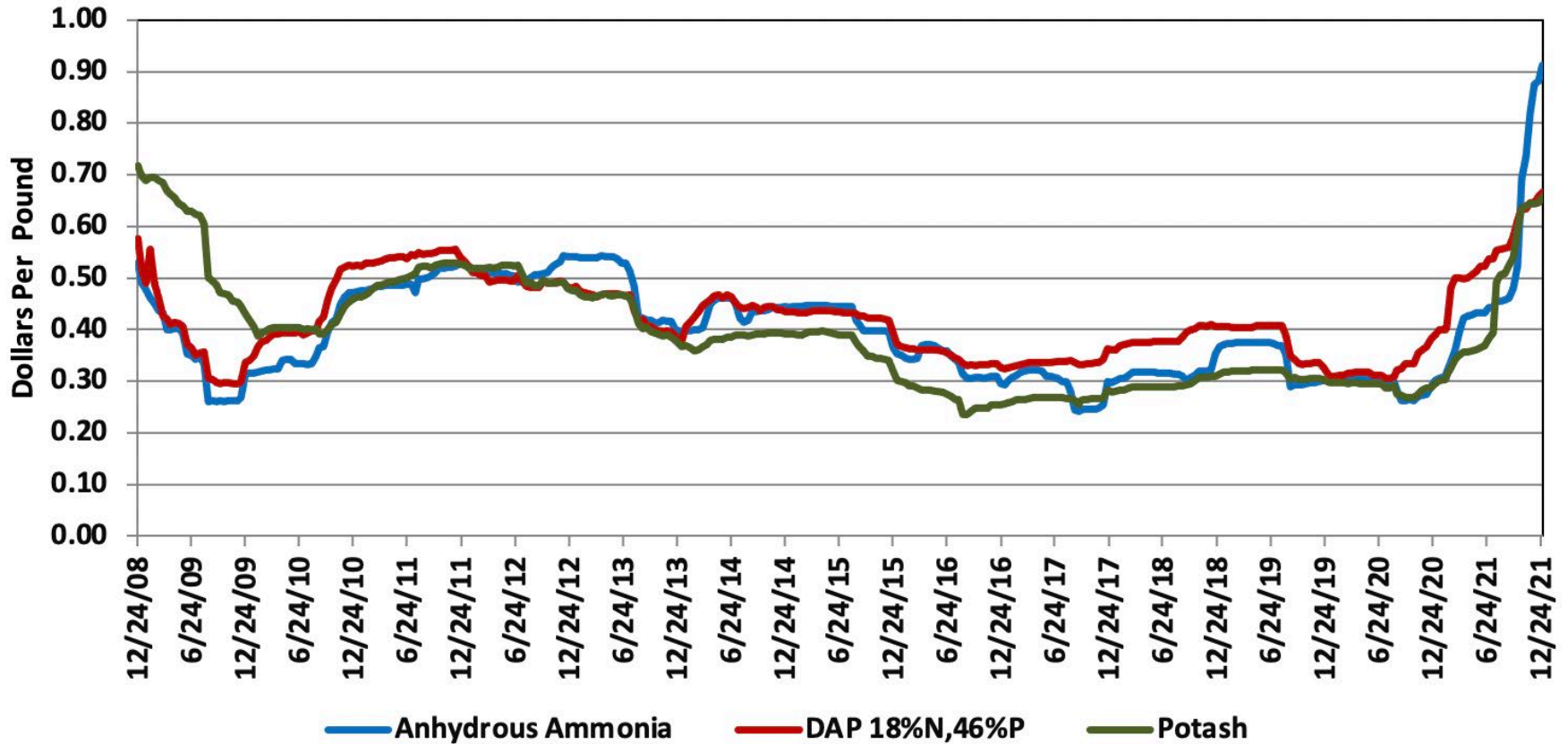

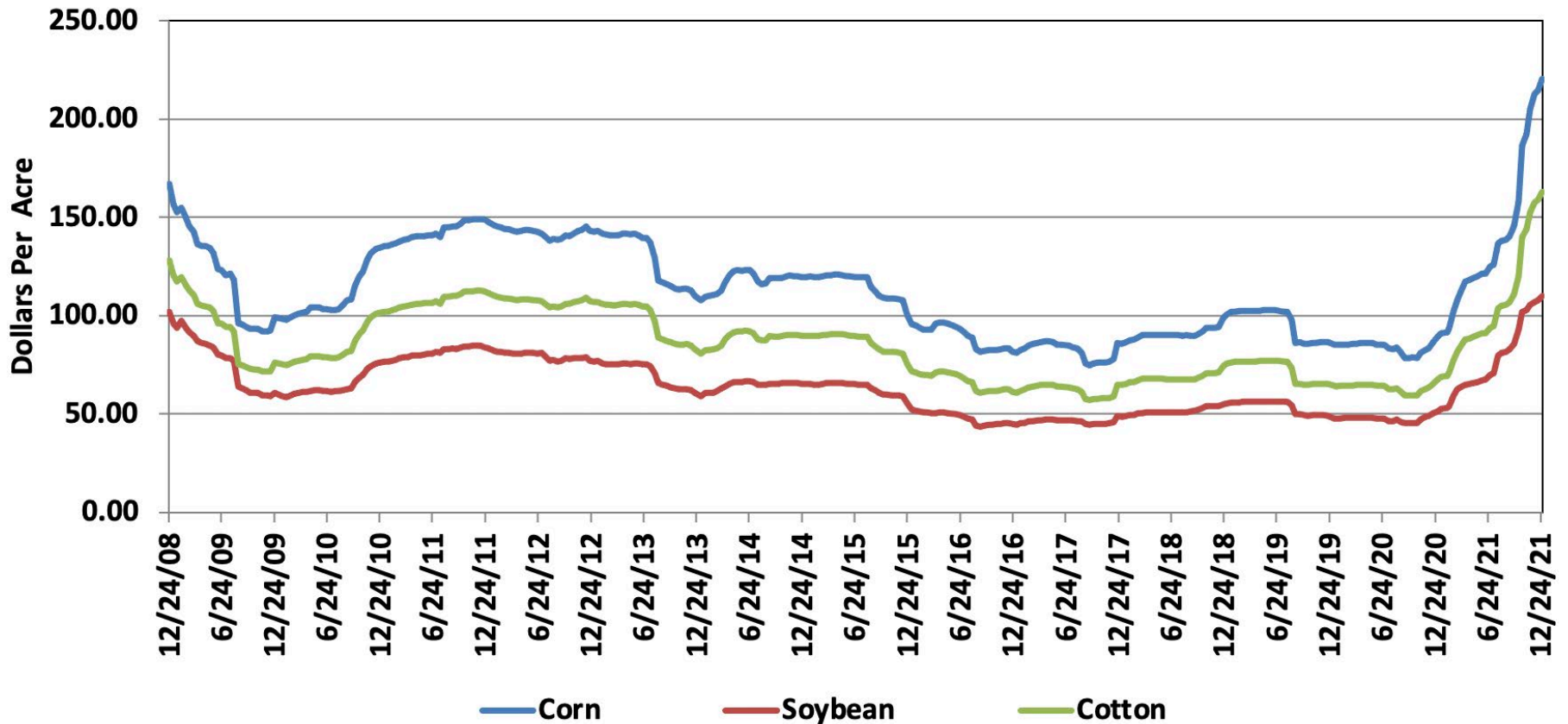

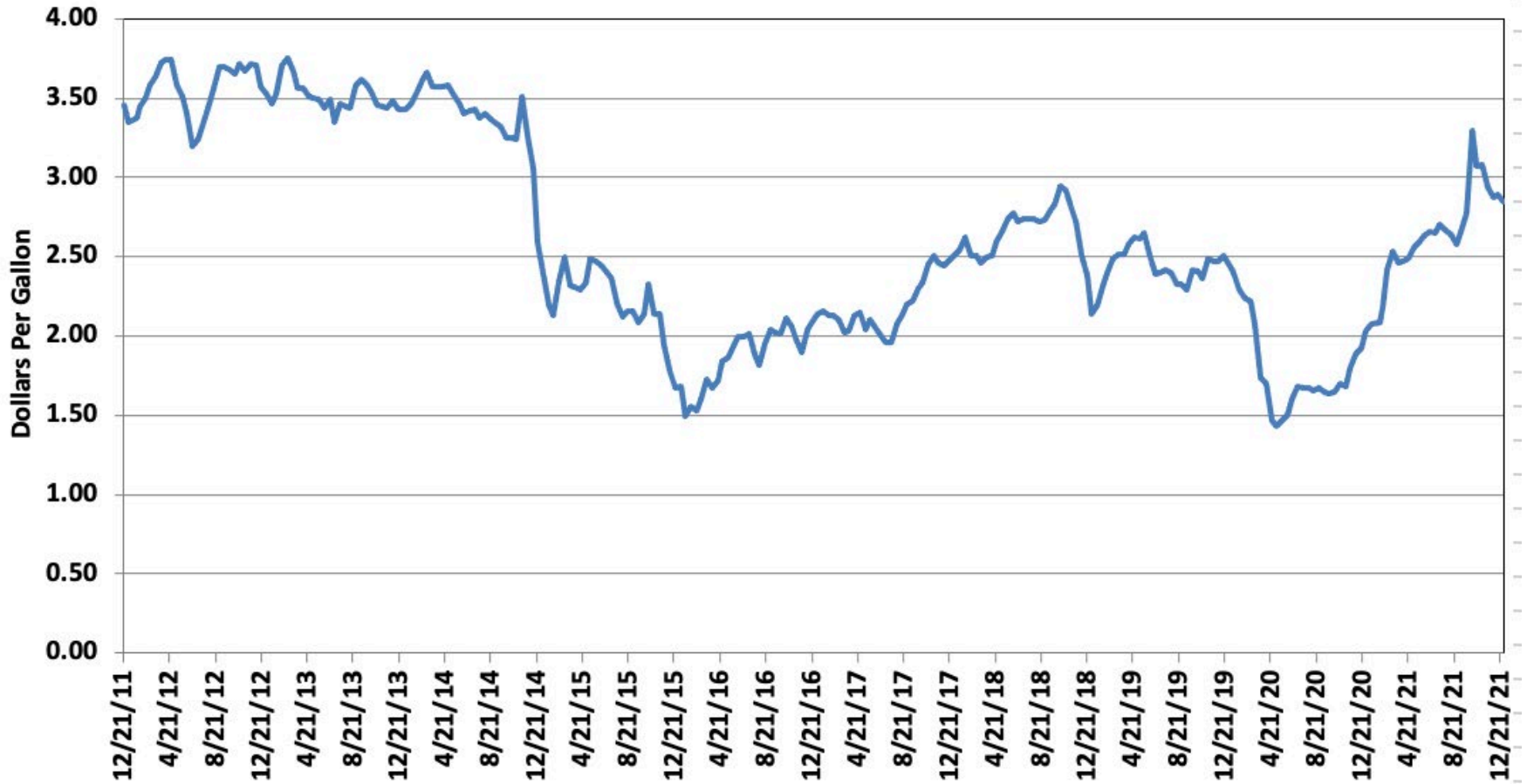
# Fertilizer Prices



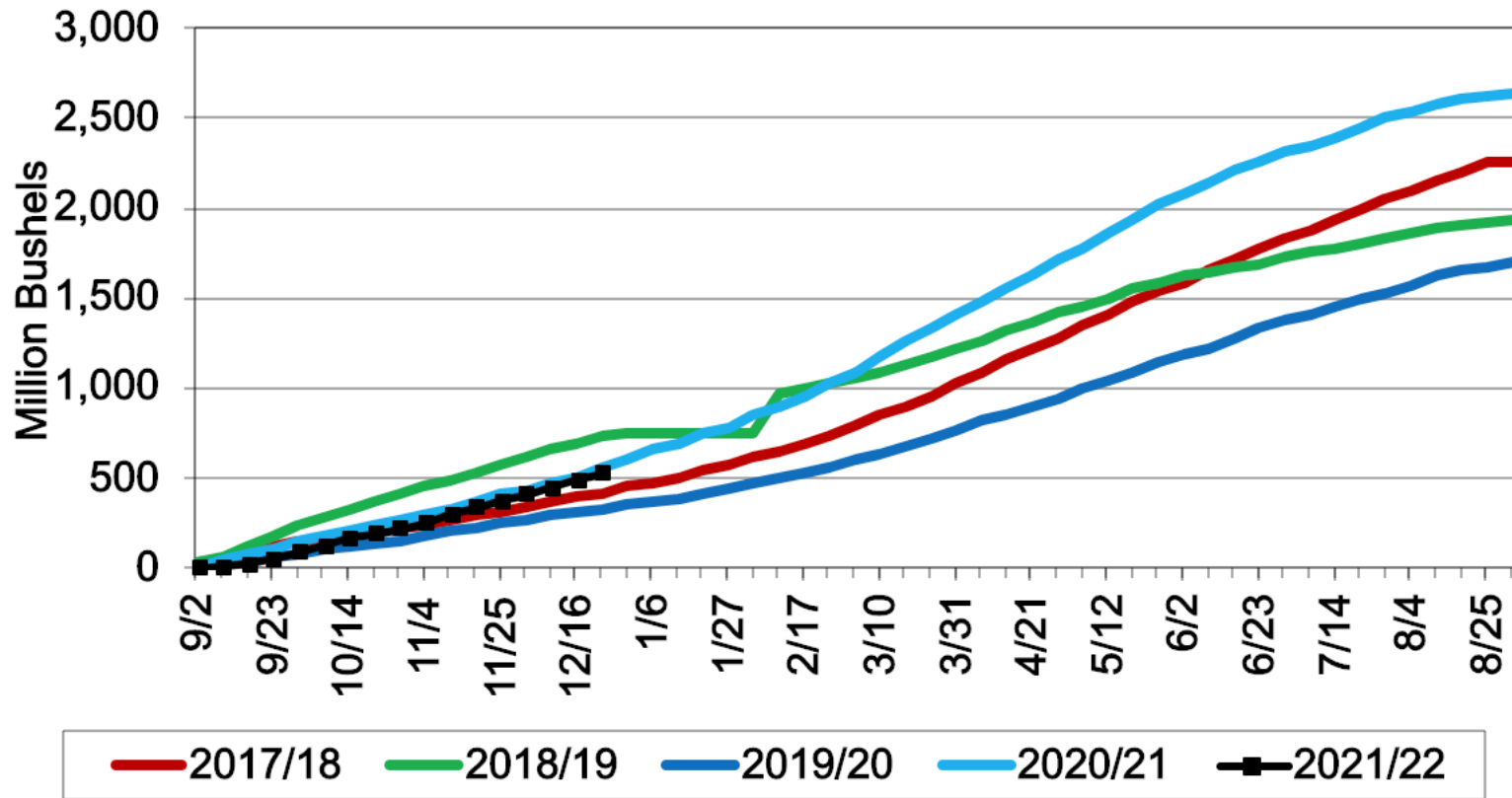
# Fertilizer Prices Per Acre

# Accumulated US Corn Exports to All Countries

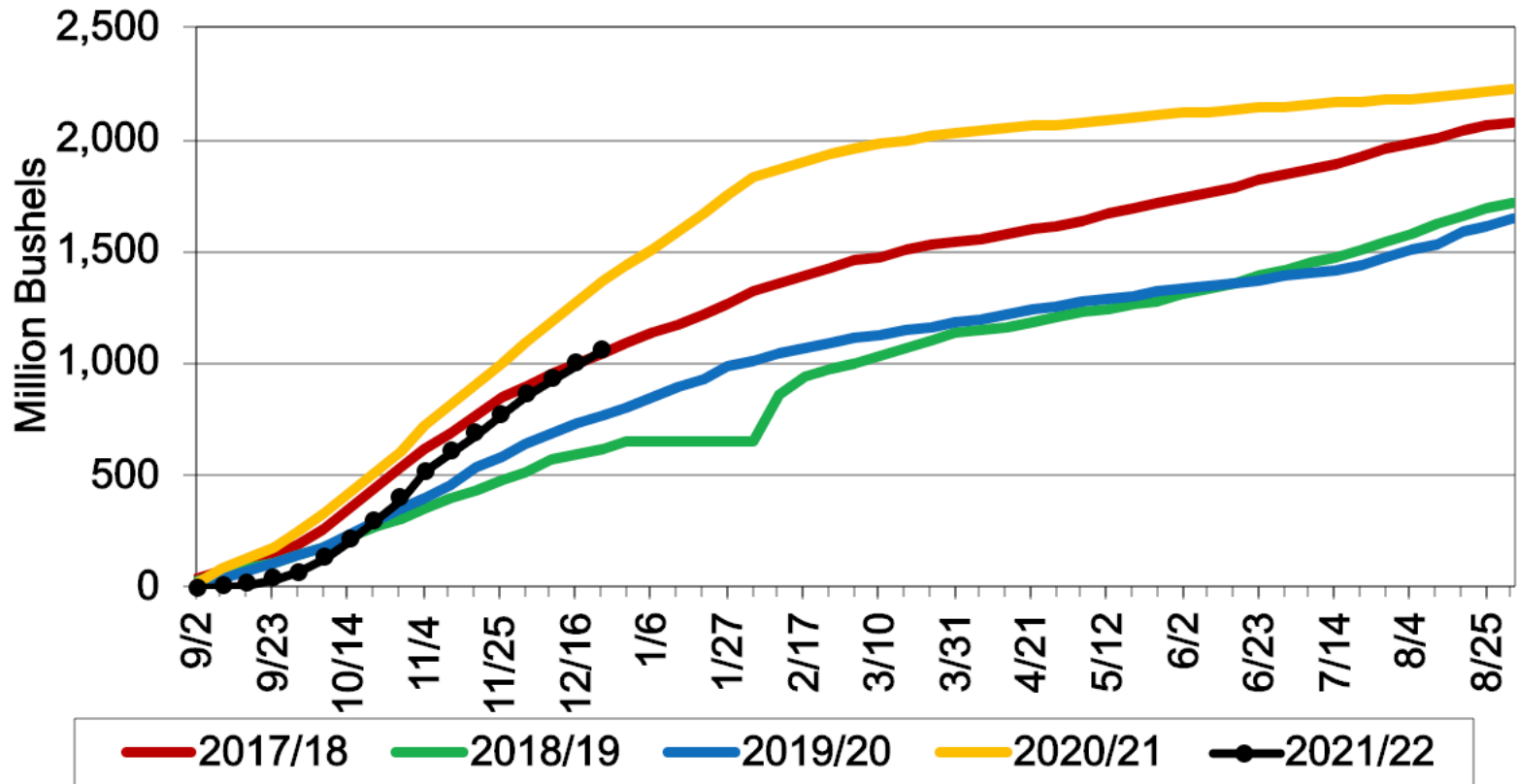


# Corn Export Summary

- Net Sales decreased 80% from the previous week and 81% from the prior 4-week average to 10.1 MBU.
- Increases were largely credited to Canada (5.9 MBU), Mexico (4.5 MBU), and Colombia (3.6 MBU).
- Exports were up 7% from the previous week, and down 2% from the prior 4-week average, totaling 38.8 MBU.
- The destinations were primarily to Japan (8.7 MBU), Mexico (8.3 MBU), and Colombia (7.1 MBU).



# Accumulated US Soybean Exports to All Countries



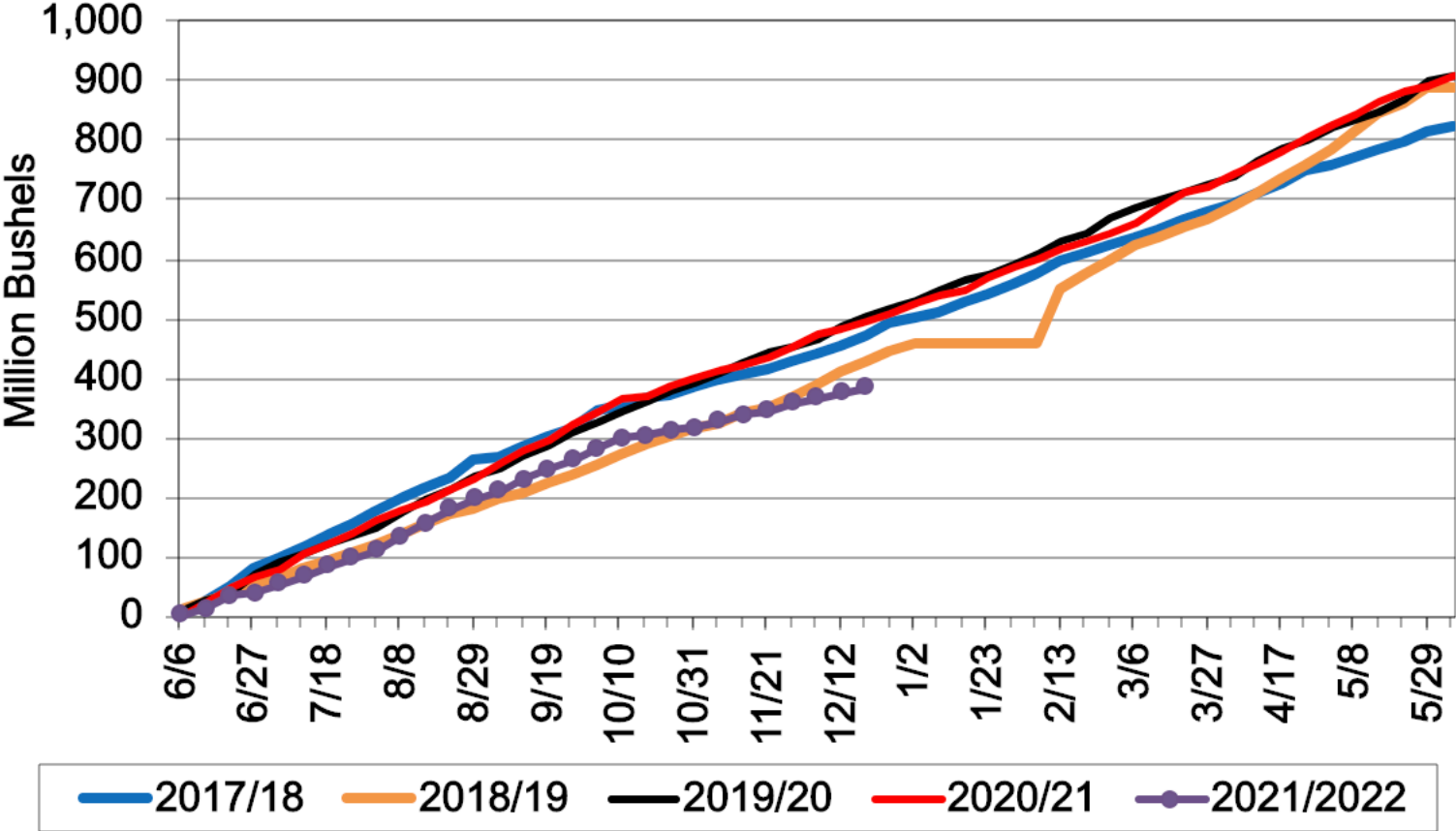
# Soybean Export Summary

- Net Sales are a marketing-year low at 14.1 MBU, down 27% compared to the previous week and 63% compared to the previous 4-week average.
- Increases are accredited to China (13 MBU), Mexico (6.8 MBU), and Spain (5.2 MBU).
- Net Sales for 2022/2023 totaled 2.5 MBU and was primarily for unknown destinations (2.4 MBU).
- Exports were at 64 MBU, up 1% from the week prior but down 11% from the previous 4-week average.
- The primary destinations were China (33.5 MBU), Egypt (5.6 MBU), and Spain (5.2 MBU).





# Accumulated US Wheat Exports to All Countries

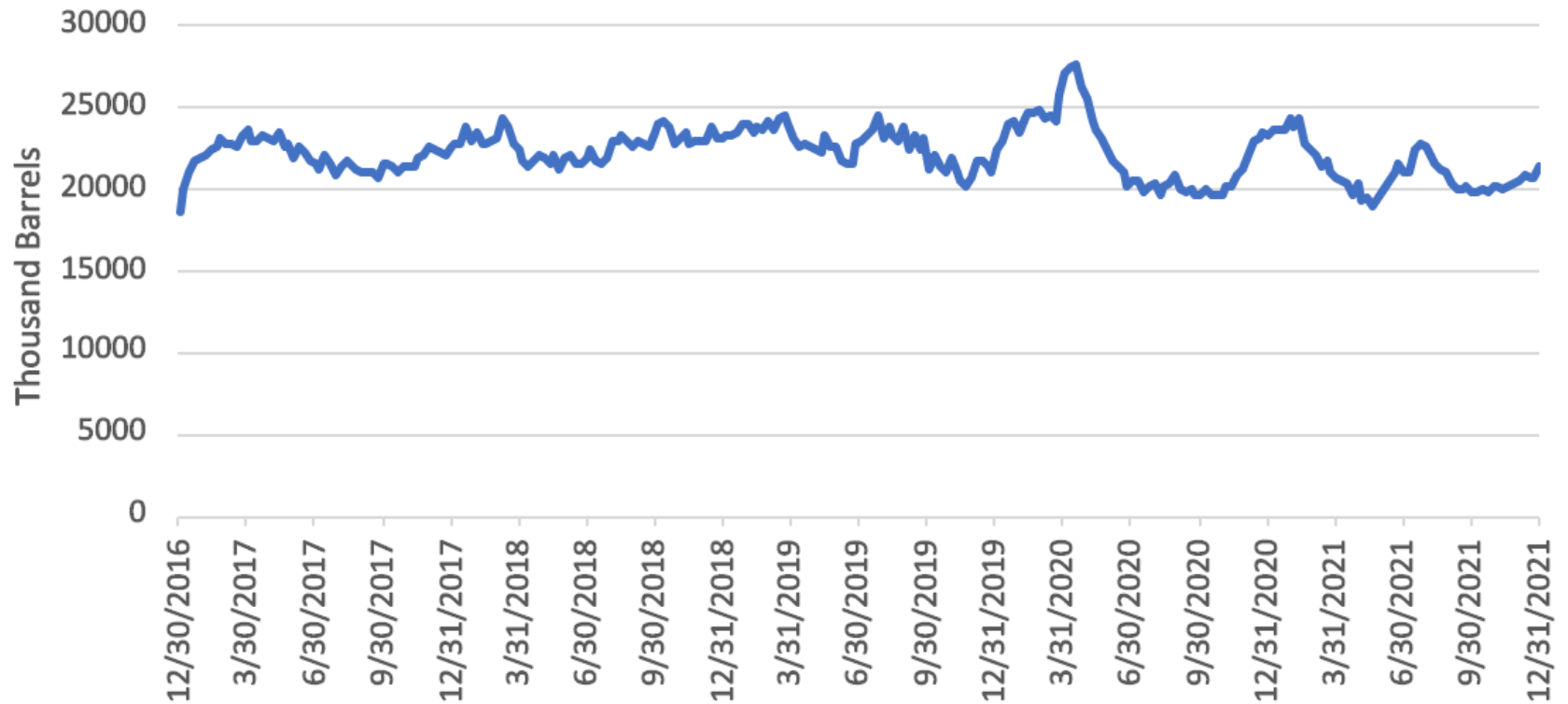


# Wheat Export Summary

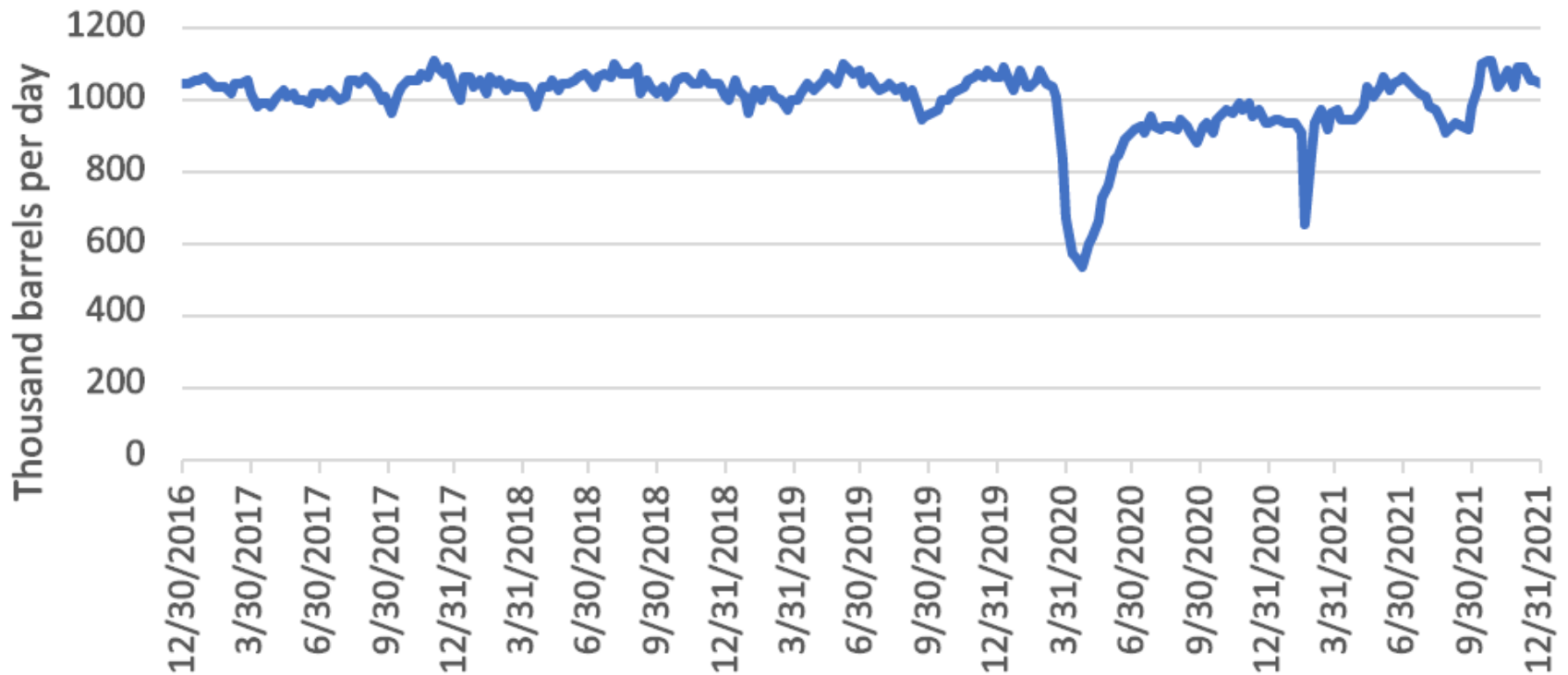
- Net Sales were at a marketing-year low at 1.8 MBU.
- Increases were primarily for Italy (566,000 BU) and for Mexico (353,000 BU)
- Net Sales for 2022/2023 were for Peru at 92,000 BU.
- Exports were down 37% from the previous week, and 17% from the prior 4-week average, totaling to 7.8 MBU.
- Destinations were primarily Nigeria (1.9 MBU), the Philippines (1.6 MBU), and Japan (1.2 MBU).
