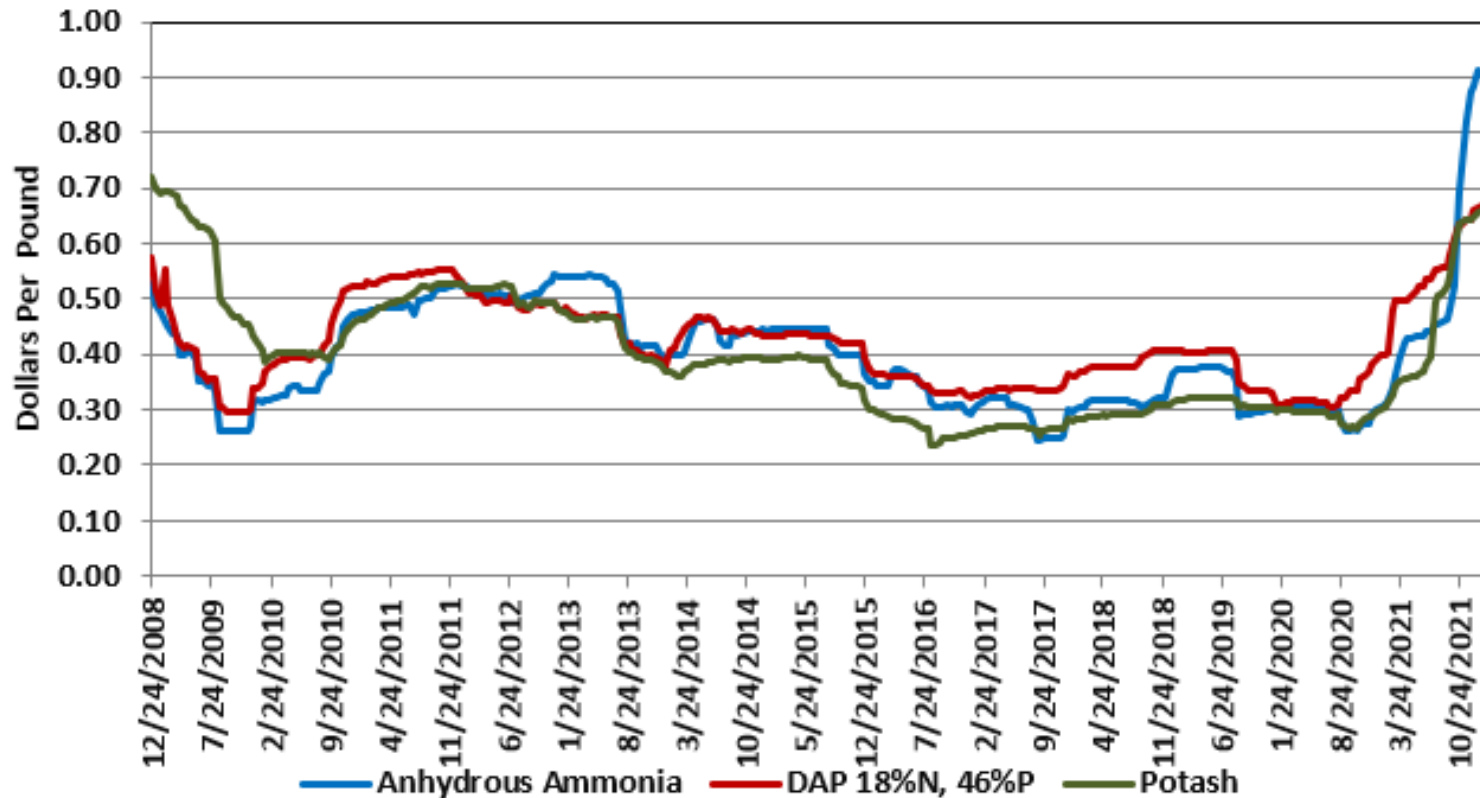

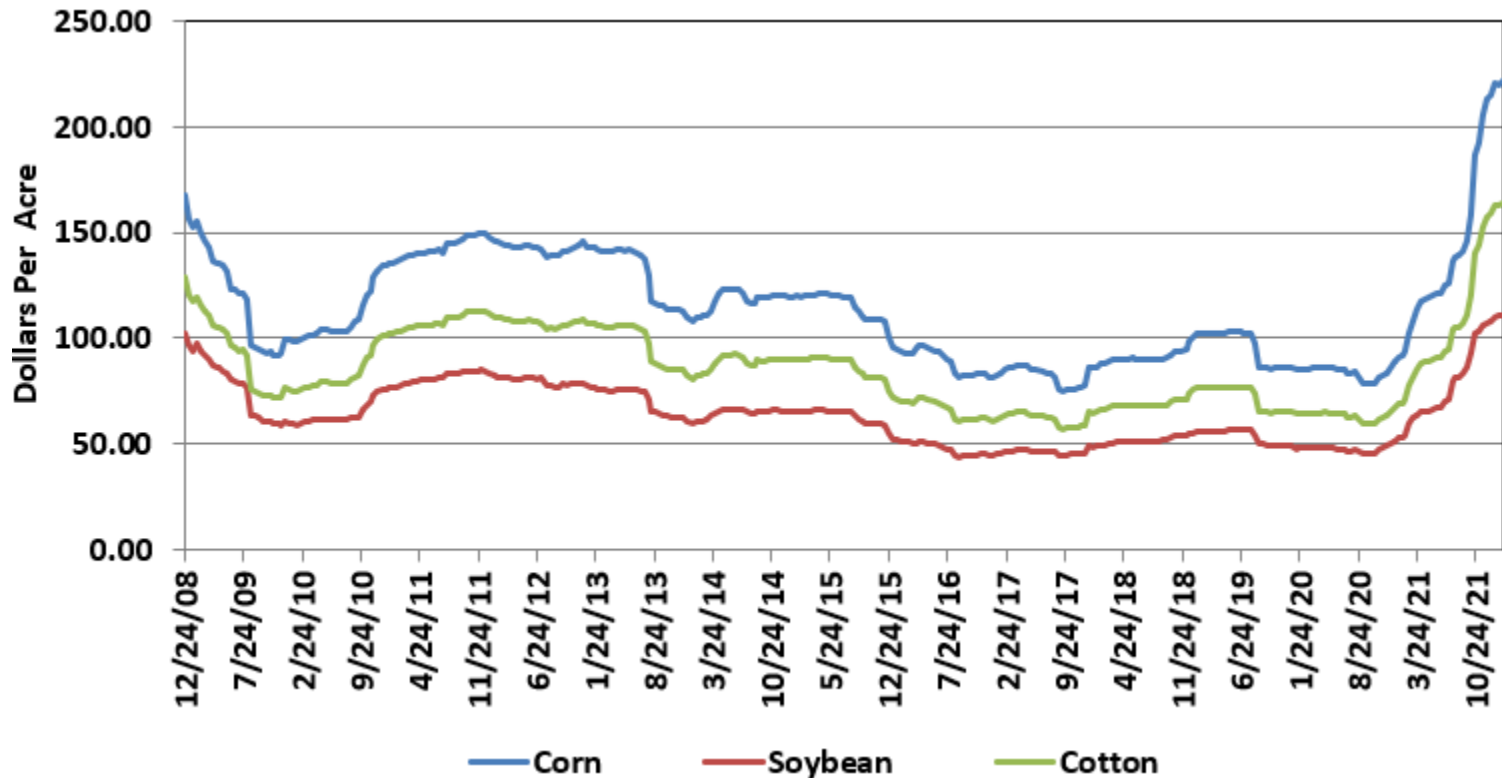

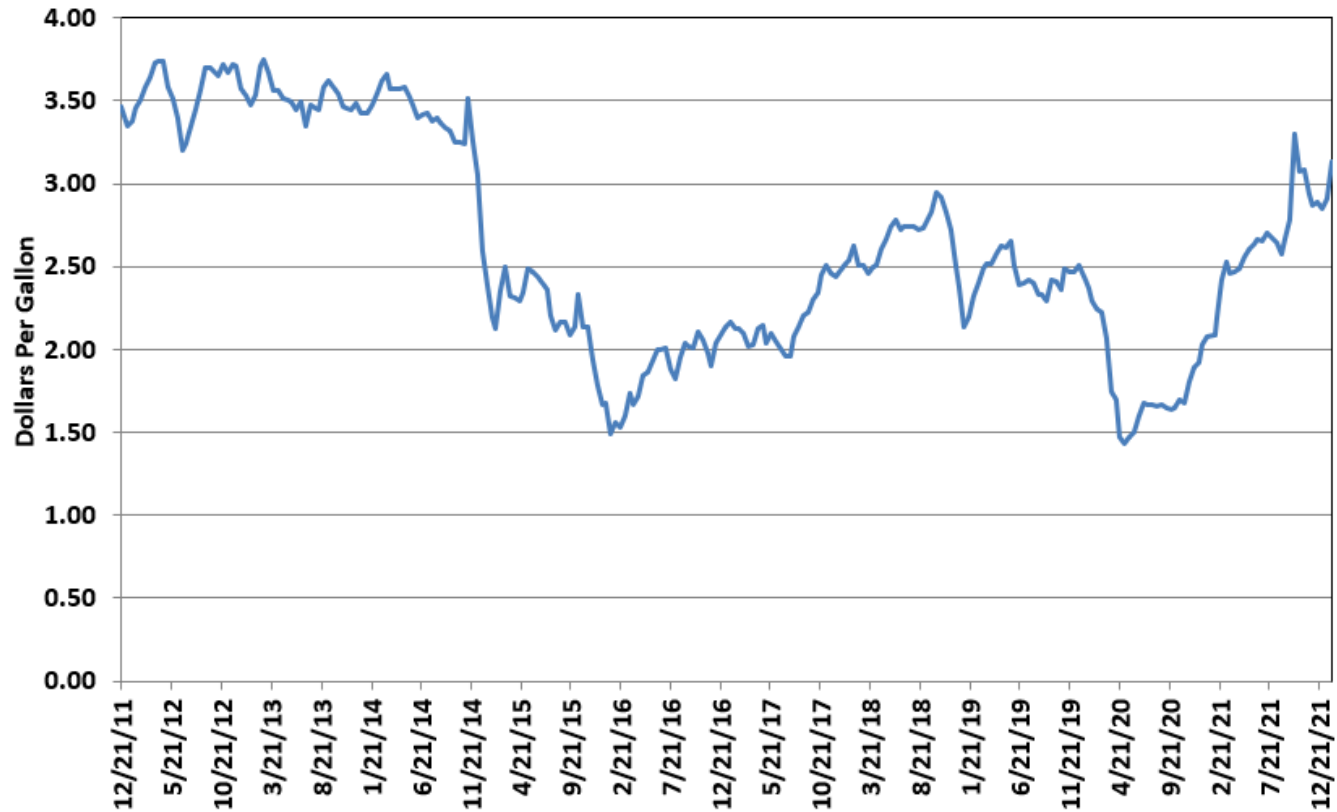
Fertilizer Prices



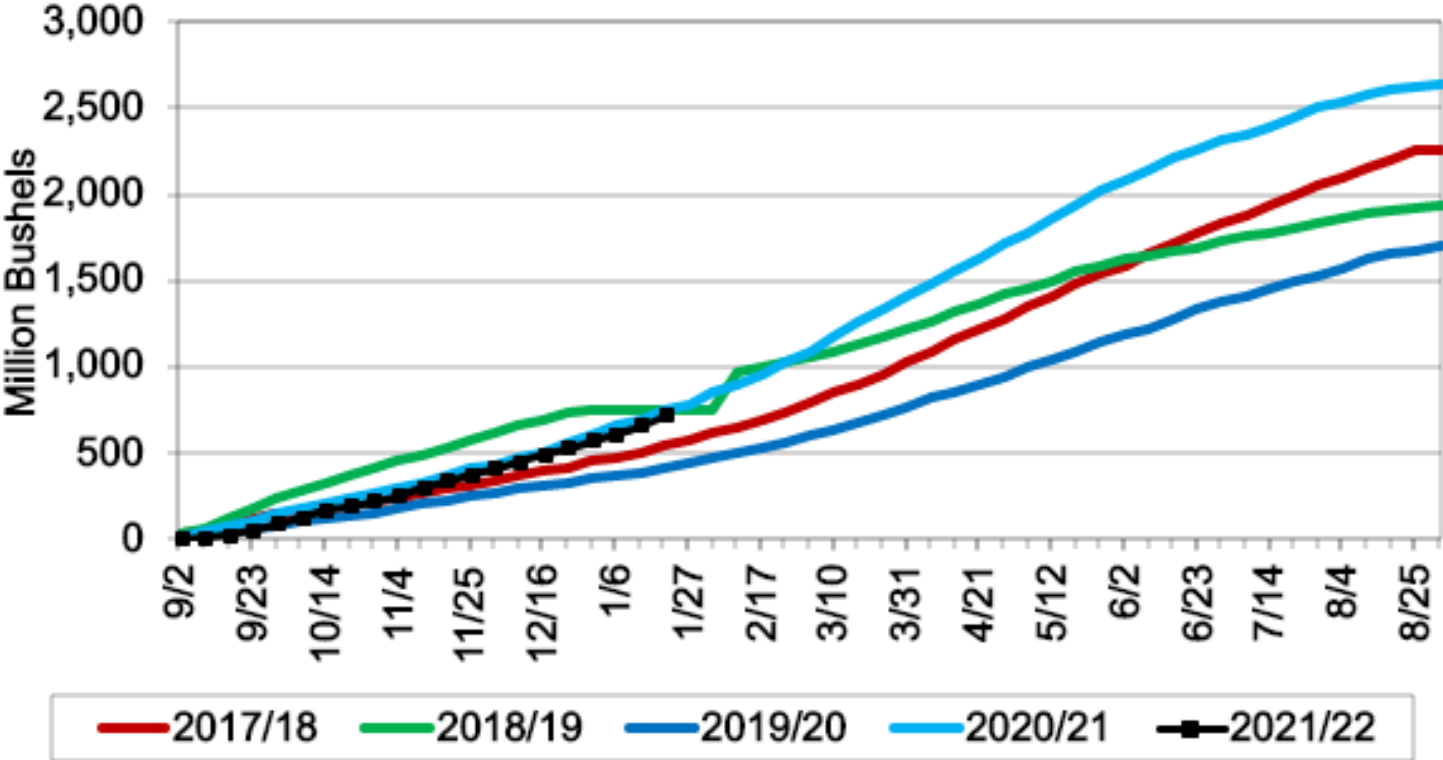
Fertilizer Prices Per Acre

Accumulated US Corn Exports to All Countries

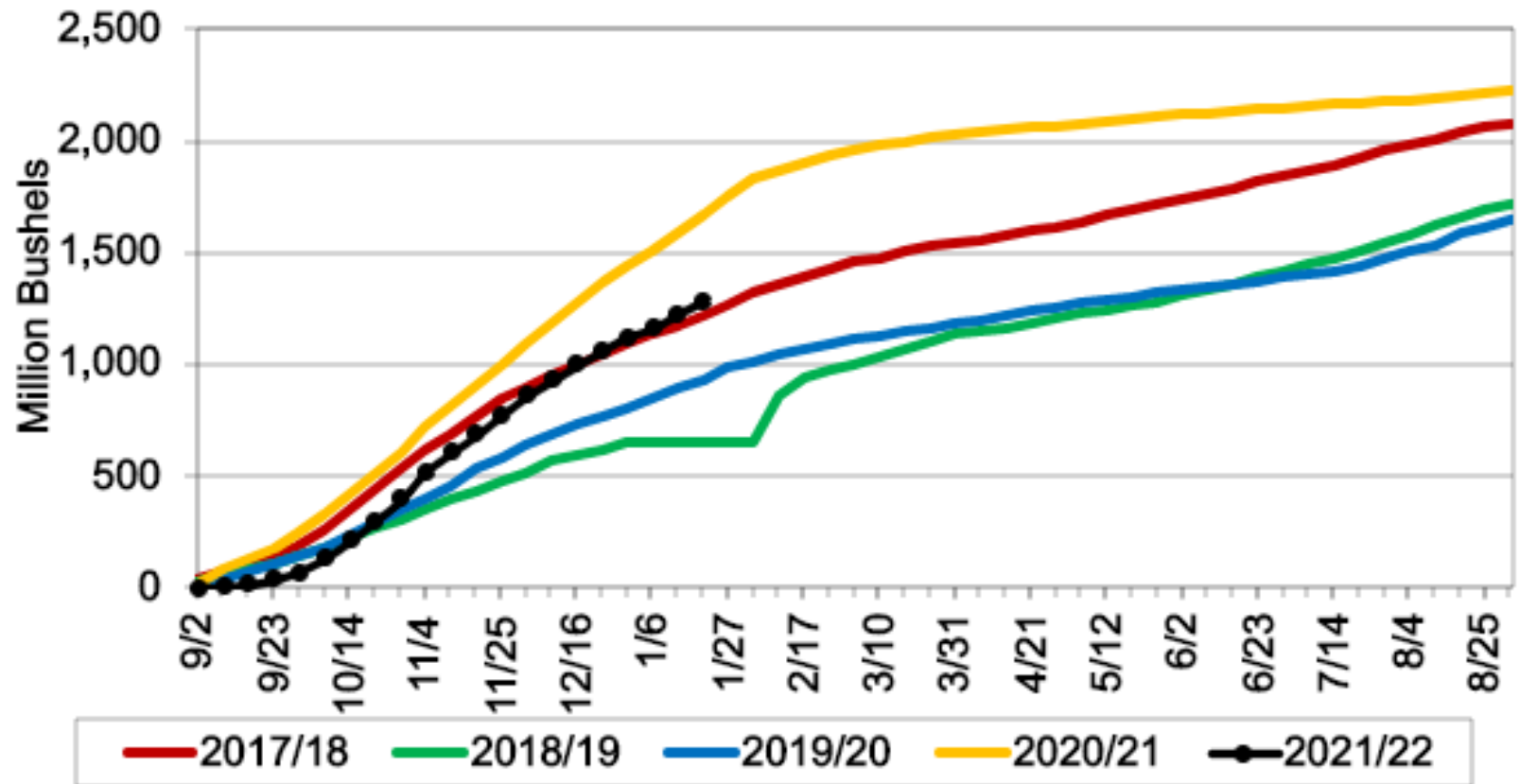


Corn Export Summary

- Net Sales for 2021 /2022 decreased 16% from the previous week, but increased 47% from the prior 4-week average at 46.3 MBU.
- Increases were largely credited to Japan (18.7 MBU) and Mexico (8.3 MBU).
- Exports were down 19% from the previous week, and 1% from the prior 4-week average at 45.9 MBU.
- The destinations were primarily to Mexico (13.6 MBU), Japan (9.7 MBU), and China (8.1 MBU).



Accumulated US Soybean Exports to All Countries

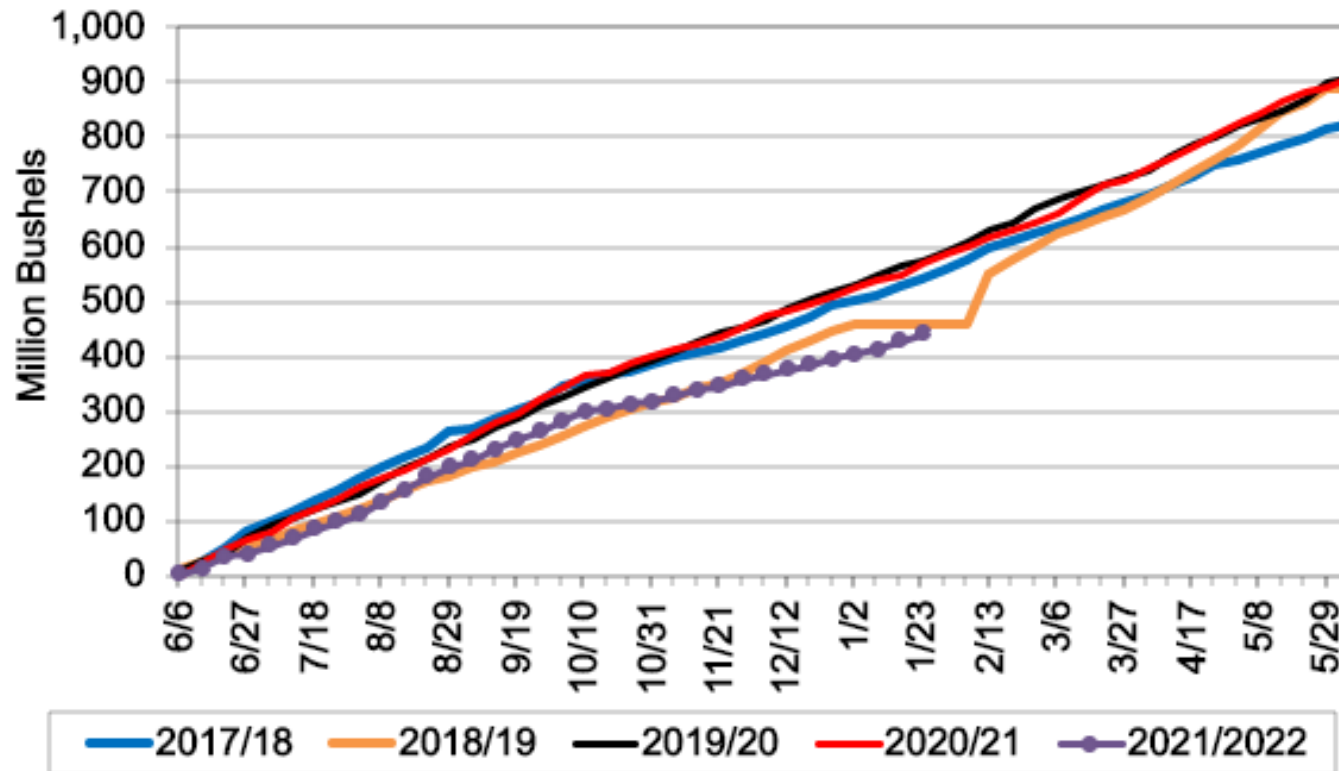


Soybean Export Summary

- Net Sales for 2021 /2022 totaled 40.2 MBU, up 7% compared to the previous week and 56% compared to the previous 4-week average.
- Increases are accredited to Mexico (13.1 MBU), Egypt (4.96 MBU), and the Netherlands (4.8 MBU).
- Net Sales for 2022/2023 totaled 32.4 MBU and was primarily for China (24.2 MBU).
- Exports were at 48.8 MBU, down 17% from the week prior, and 14% from the previous 4-week average.
- The primary destinations were China (26.6 MBU), the Netherlands (4.8 MBU), and Taiwan (3.4 MBU).

Wheat Export Summary

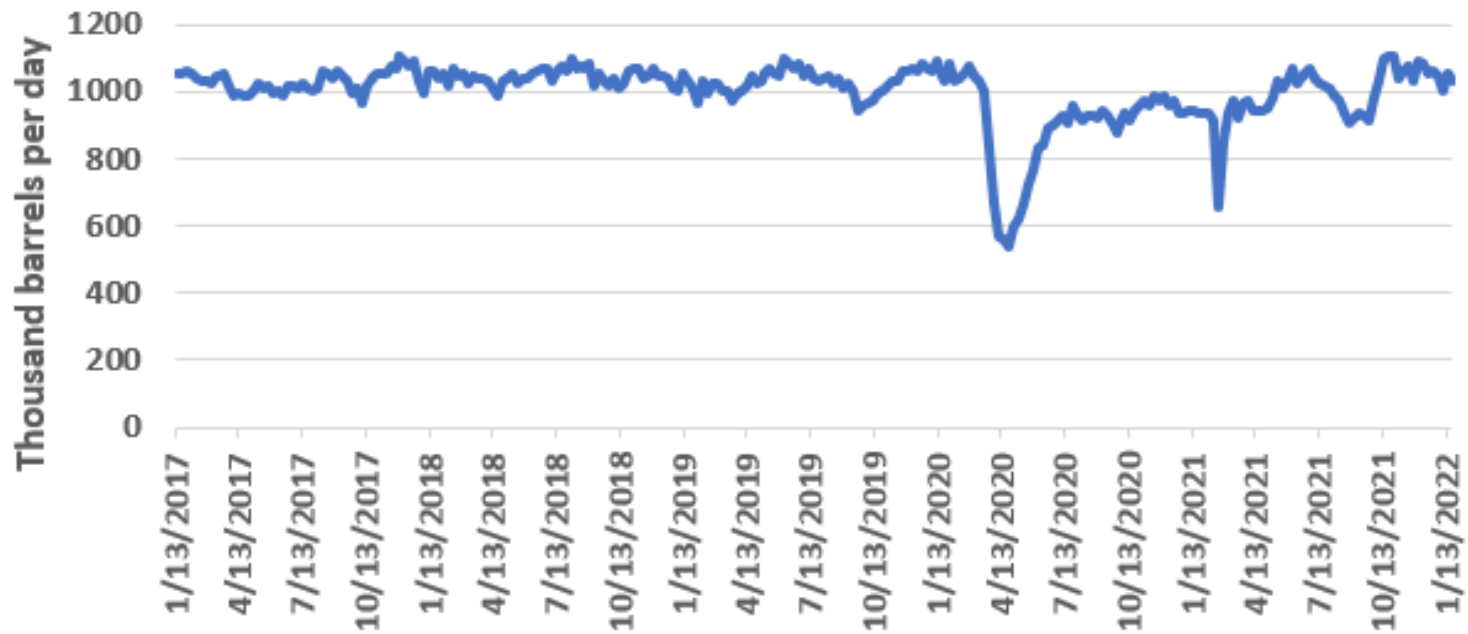
- Net Sales for 2021 /2022 were at 2.1 MBU, down 92% from the prior week, and 83% from the previous 4-week average.
- Increases were primarily for Colombia (1.94 MBU) and Nigeria (1.91 MBU).
- Net Sales for 2022/2023 totaled to 3.8 MBU and was primarily for the Philippines (1.84 MBU).
- Exports were up 6% from the previous week, and 26% from the prior 4-week average, totaling to 14.1 MBU.
- Destinations were primarily to Japan (4.4 MBU), Colombia (2.4 MBU), and Thailand (2 MBU)
