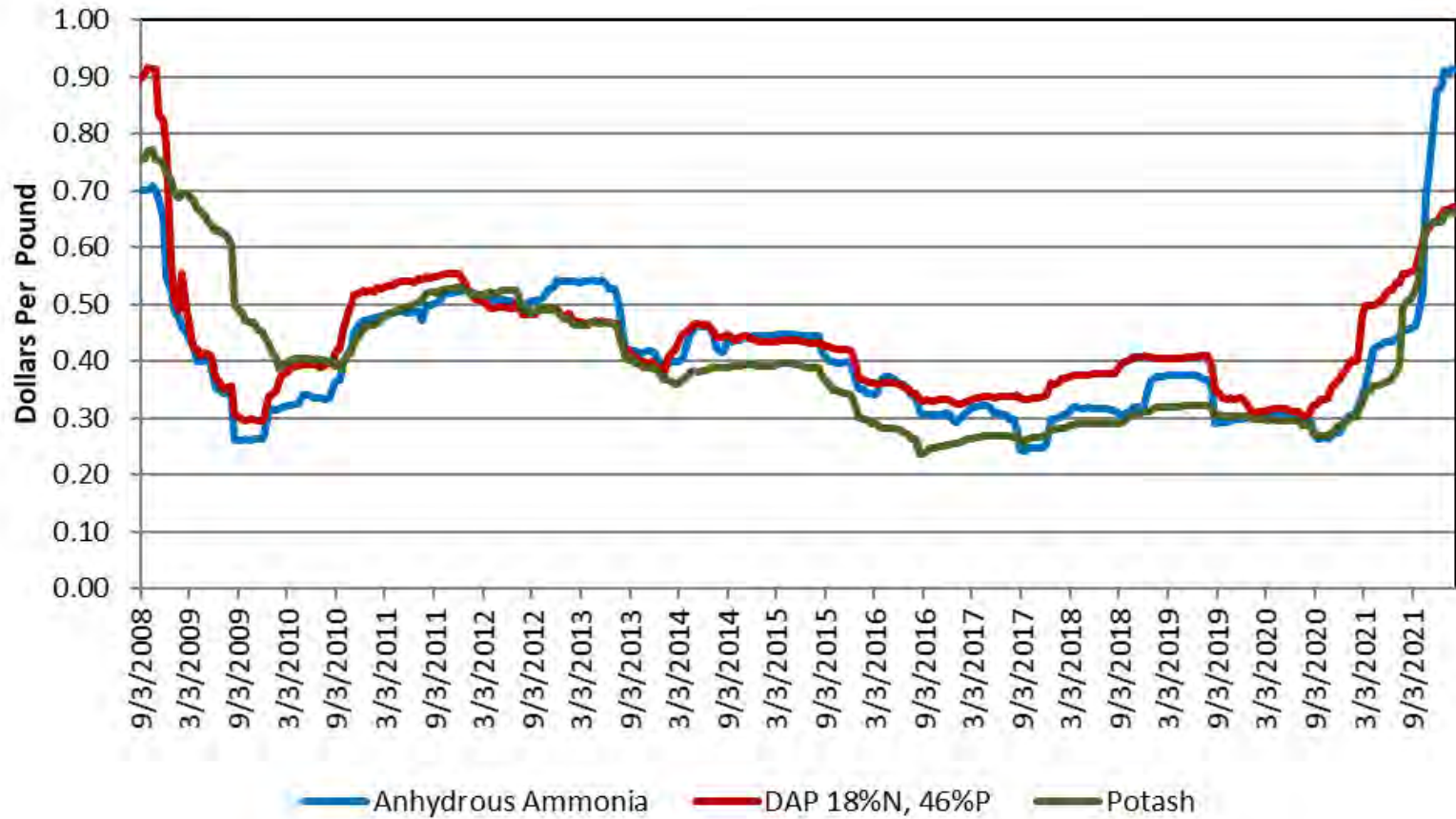

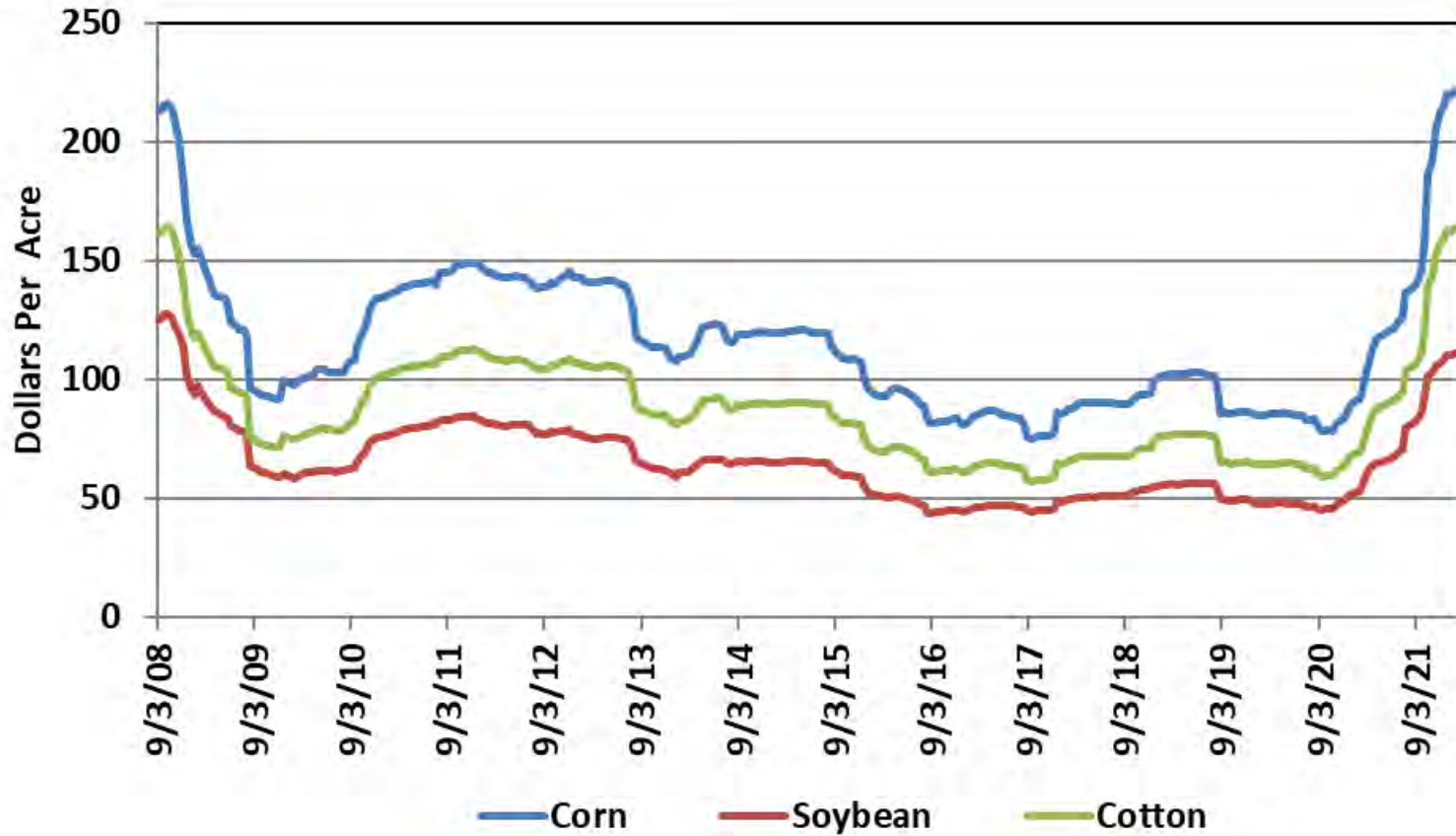

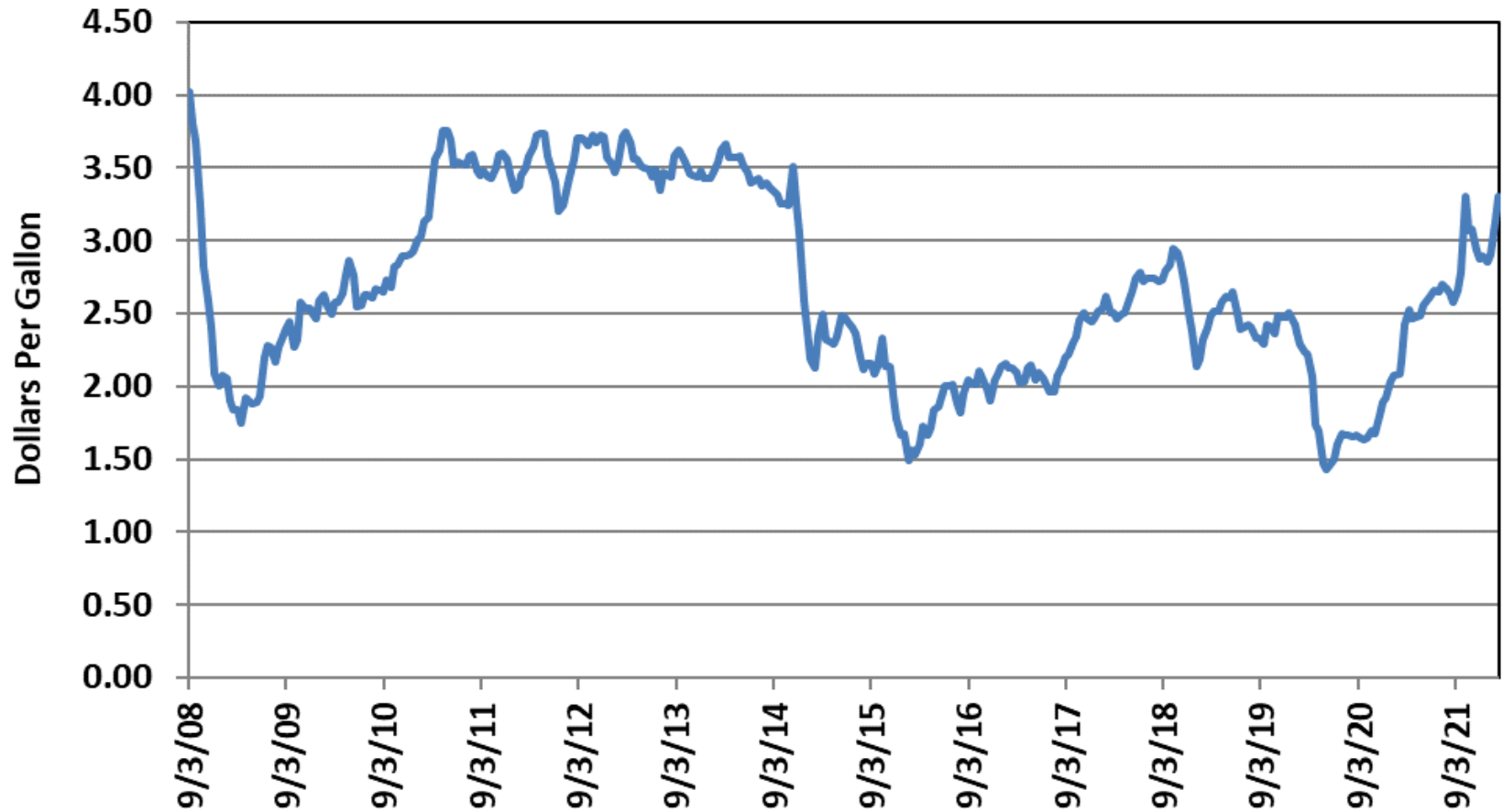
Fertilizer Prices



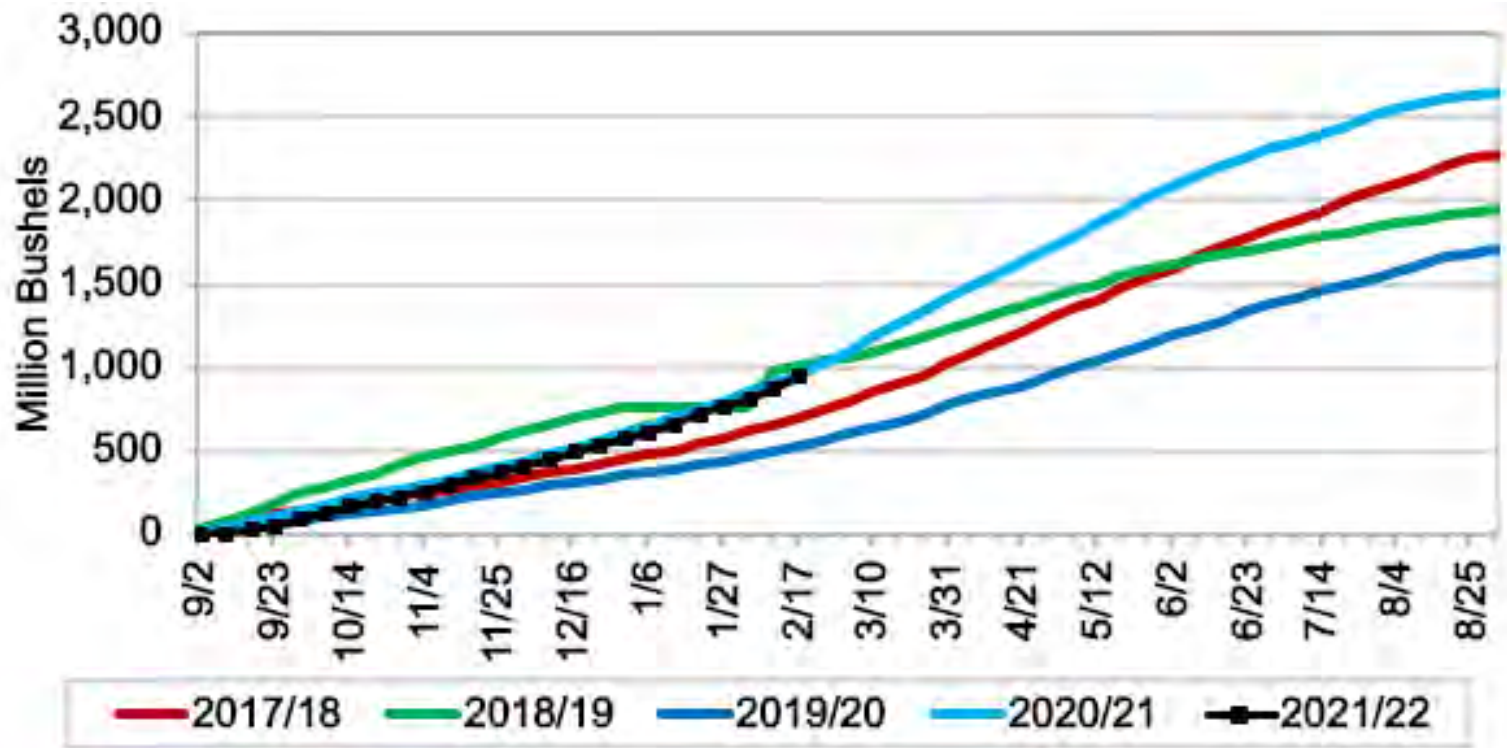
Fertilizer Prices Per Acre

Accumulated US Corn Exports to All Countries

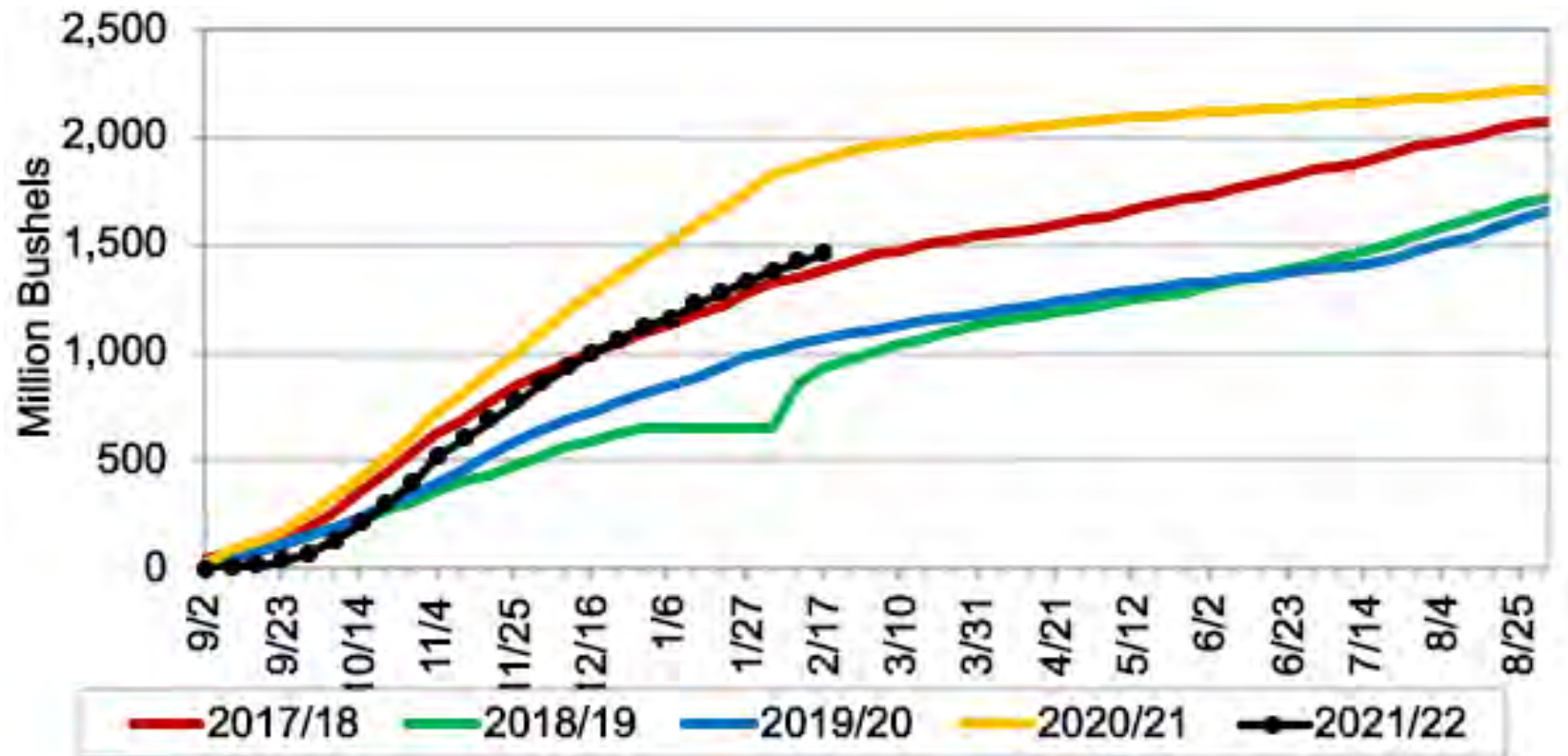


Corn Export Summary

- Net Sales for 2021 /2022 increased 39% from the previous week, but decreased 23% from the prior 4-week average at 32.3 MBU.
- Increases were largely credited to Japan (23.6 MBU) and Mexico (4.1 MBU).
- Net Sales for 2022/2023 totaled 4.5 MBU, reporting for Mexico (3.5 MBU) and Japan (925,148 BU).
- Exports were at a marketing-year high at 63.7 MBU, up 41% from the previous week, and 28% from the prior 4-week average.
- The destinations were primarily to Mexico (18.8 MBU), China (16.3 MBU), and Japan (11.5 MBU).



Accumulated US Soybean Exports to All Countries

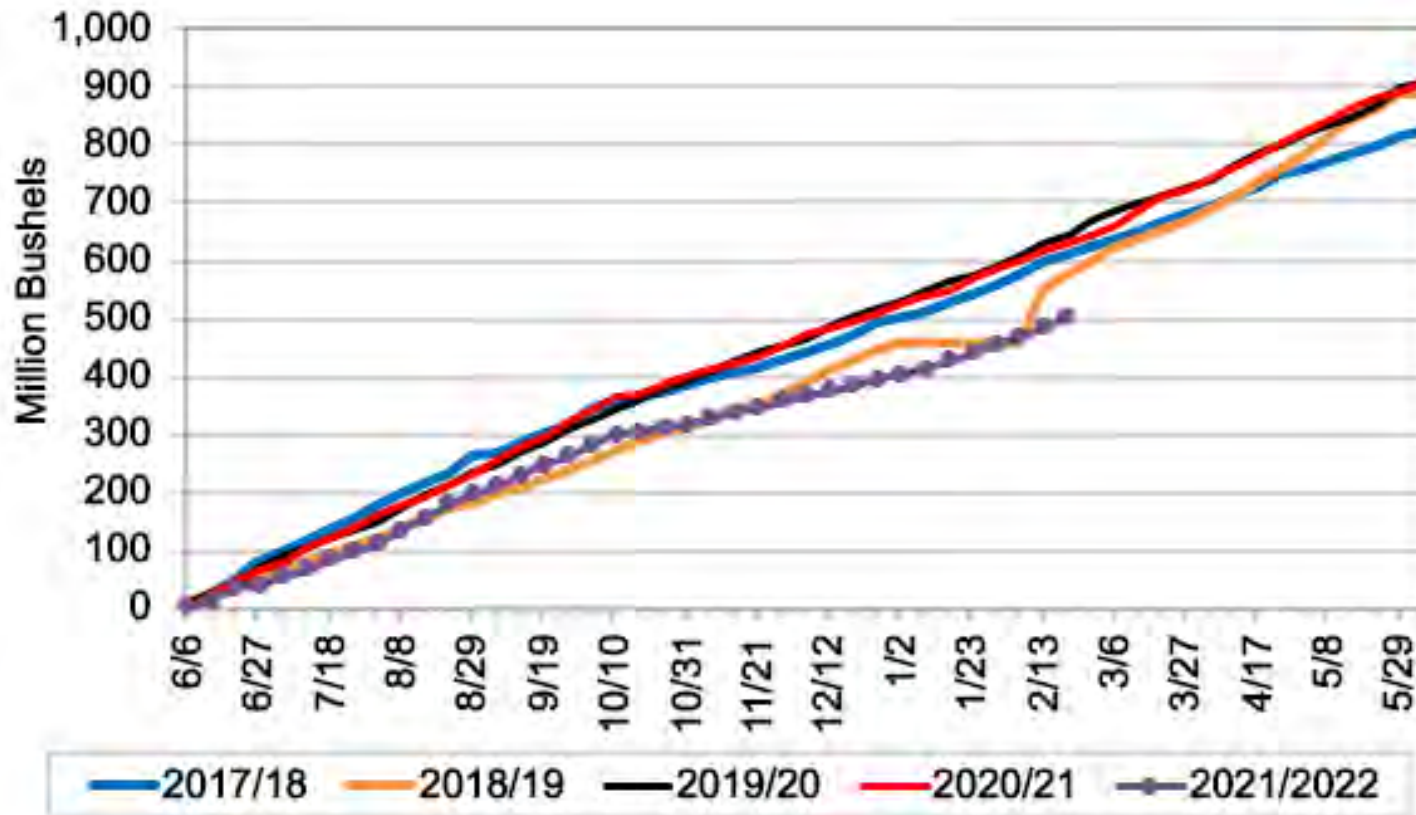


Soybean Export Summary

- Net Sales for 2021/2022 totaled 50 MBU, down 15% compared to the previous week, but up 26% compared to the previous 4-week average.
- Increases are accredited to unknown destinations (13.7 MBU), China (8.2 MBU), and the Netherlands (6.9 MBU).
- Net Sales for 2022/2023 totaled 56.1 MBU and was primarily for China (32.2 MBU) and unknown destinations (19.5 MBU).
- Exports were at 44.6 MBU, down 7% from the week prior, and 19% from the previous 4-week average.
- The primary destinations were China (21.2 MBU), the Netherlands (4.5 MBU), and Mexico (4.4 MBU).
- For 2021/2022, the current exports for own account outstanding balance is 110,220 BU, all Canada.



Accumulated US Wheat Exports to All Countries

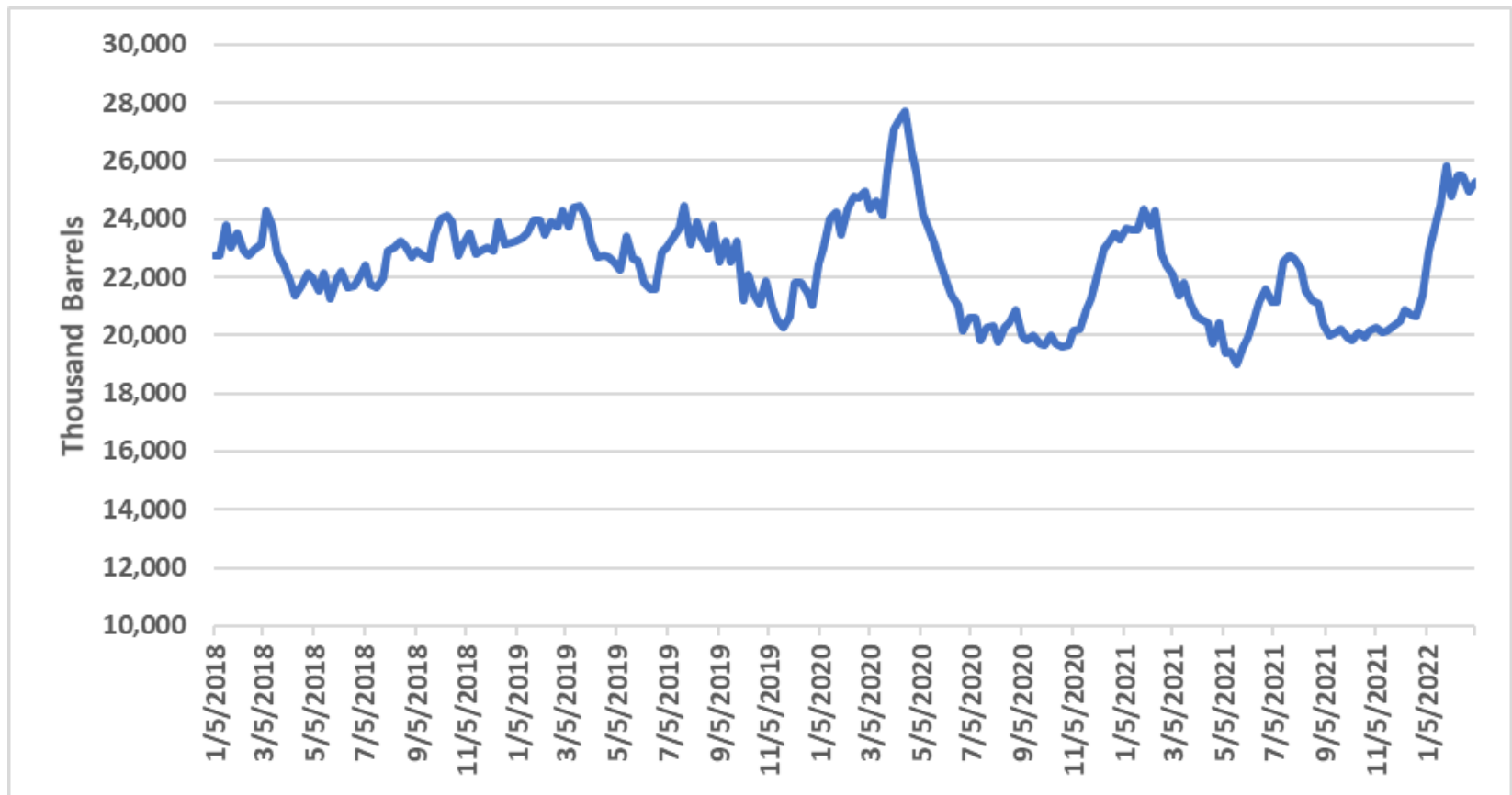


Wheat Export Summary

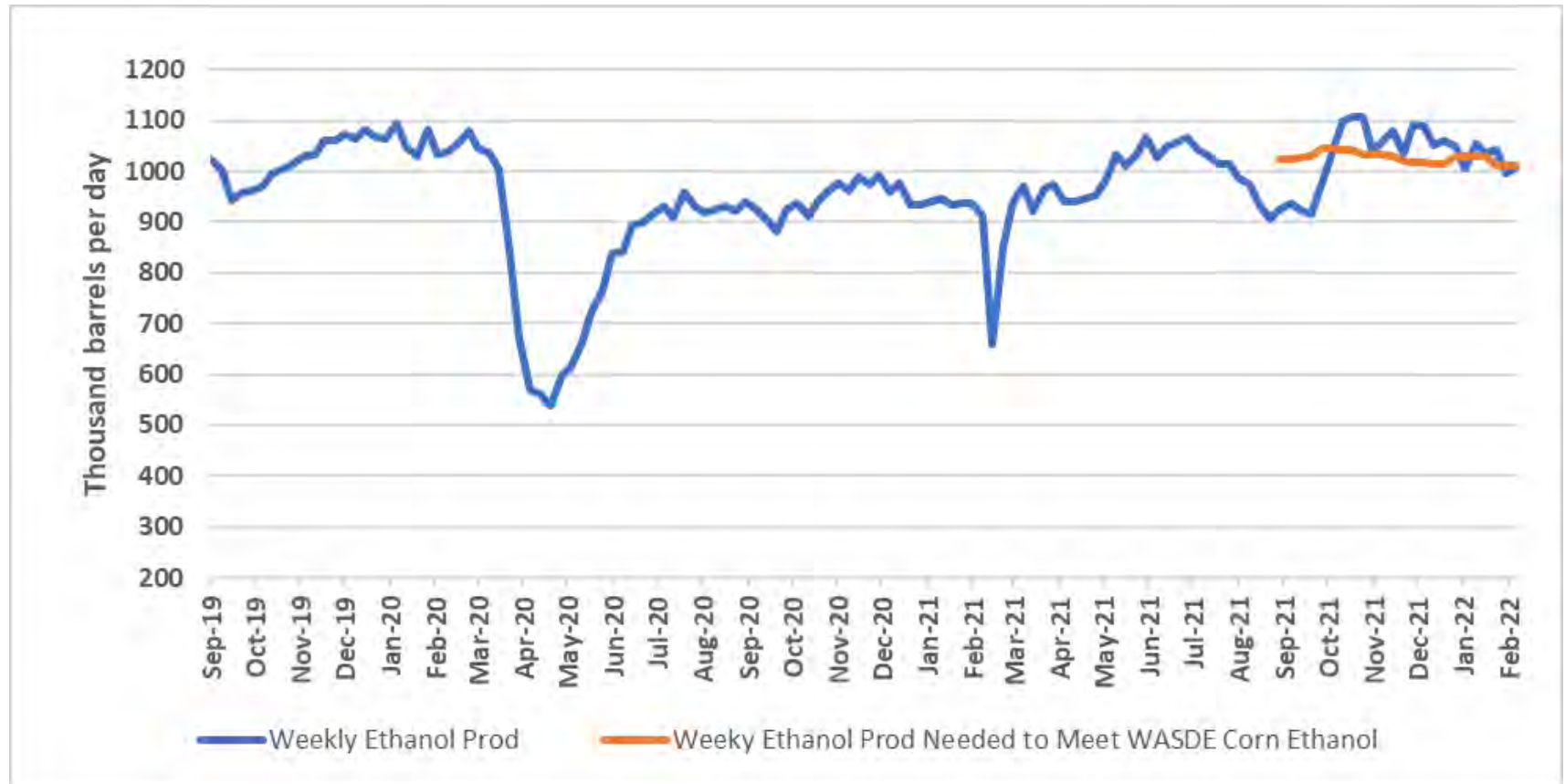
- Net Sales for 2021/2022 were at 4.3 MBU, up 39% from the prior week, but down 61% from the previous 4-week average.
- Increases were primarily for Guatemala (1.4 MBU) and Mexico (1.03 MBU).
- Net Sales for 2022/2023 totaled to 385,770 BU and was for Peru.
- Exports were up 8% from the previous week, and 9% from the prior 4-week average, totaling to 15.1 MBU.
- Destinations were primarily to Mexico (3.4 MBU), Taiwan (2.5 MBU), and the Philippines (2.3 MBU).
